GOVERNOR TO SIGN BILLS REIGNING IN DEADBEAT DADS, ENSURING CHILD SUPPORT FOR NEW JERSEY CHILDREN

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will sign legislation that helps reign in deadbeat dads and provides for more strict enforcement of child support orders. The laws will work in conjunction with federal law to ensure uniform enforcement and collection of child support across state lines.

Gov. Whitman will be joined at the bill signing ceremony by people who have experienced difficulty in collecting child support. Human Services Commissioner William Waldman and legislative sponsors will also join the Governor for the ceremony in her outer office at the State House in Trenton at 1:30 p.m.
