SUBJECT: AIDS Community Care Alternatives Program (ACCAP)

This is to advise you that ACCAP, which was initiated on March 1, 1987, and described in Medicaid Communication 87-10, dated March 30, 1987, has been revised as follows:

1. AIDS Related Complex (ARC) no longer is acceptable as a diagnosis for entry into this program. Individuals must be diagnosed as having AIDS, or if a child under 5, be HIV positive.
2. The reevaluation of need for nursing facility care, an annual requirement for this program, will be carried out by the ACCAP nurse case manager, rather than the Medicaid District Office Regional Staff Nurse, as is current practice.
3. ACCAP Statewide program slots have been increased to 1000. The slot allocation by county is attached.
