The region's total passenger traffic reached a record 11.81 million travelers (+458,645 travelers/+4 percent) in October. The international sector set the pace with 278,583 added passengers (+7.1 percent) to a record 4.186 million travelers. Domestic passenger traffic also hit a new mark of 7.624 million passengers (+180,062 travelers/+2.4 percent). Airlines expanded total seats by 4.4 percent. Domestic and international seats grew by 4.1 and 5 percent, respectively. Following two months of slower growth, the region's total freight volume bounced back with a 2.7 percent improvement (+5,582 tons). Domestic cargo activity continues to lead growth with a 6 percent climb (+4,297 tons). This solid growth seems to indicate a strong Christmas shopping season ahead. Conversely, international cargo, representing over 60 percent of total traffic, continues to struggle as it inched up 1 percent (+1,285 tons).
