

Dear Mr. Weber:

The Executive Commission on Ethical Standards has reviewed your request for an advisory opinion on the question of whether any provision of the New Jersey Conflicts of Interest Law would preclude a member of a County Tax Board from holding the uncompensated post of County Chairman of a political party.

After careful consideration of all the facts presented, and an evaluation of the duties and authority vested in both positions, it is the opinion of the Executive Commission on Ethical Standards that the concurrent service by one individual as a Commissioner of a County Tax Board and County Chairman of a political party does not constitute a conflict of interest in accordance with the provisions of the New Jersey Conflicts of Interest Law.
