Administrative Report

Presented by Chris Salmi, Division of Air Quality

1. On October 17th Commissioner Martin submitted a SIP Revision for multi-pollutant infrastructure SIP. An infrastructure SIP demonstrates a state has the authority to implement an air pollution control program (Air Monitoring, Planning, Permitting, and Enforcement).
2. DC Court of Appeals lifted the stay on the USEPA Cross State Air Pollution Rule (CSAPR). It is expected the EPA will implement the Phase 1 cap (originally 2012) in 2015. This rule was designed to address transport for the old 85ppb NAAQS.
3. Expect EPA to propose a revision to the ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) on December 1. The proposal is expected to include: a primary or health standard in the range of 60-70ppb and the secondary or welfare standard using the W126 metric to protect crops, plants, and surfaces.
4. The Air Permitting program is beginning an outreach effort to the dry cleaning industry in advance of the USEPA December 21, 2020 ban on use of PERC dry cleaning machines in buildings co-located with residences.
5. Public notice on the Liberty Grove Memorial Gardens, Old Bridge Township replacement crematory unit is expected to be released for public comment soon.
6. Ocean County Landfill – an Air Operating Permit modification was issued, allowing the installation and operation of screeners as part excavation of a 1975 landfill cell. The permit includes an odor monitoring program. Odors are not expected.
7. Richelle Wormley accepted the position of Director of the Division of Air and Hazardous Materials Enforcement (DAHME).
