The region's total air passenger traffic set a record for the month of October – 11.8 million travelers (+0.03 percent/+3,035 passengers). Growth was driven entirely by the domestic sector's new mark of 7.7 million passengers (+0.6 percent/+49,488 travelers). Carriers increased domestic seats by 1.1 percent. International passenger volume fell (-1.1 percent/-46,453 travelers) as carriers cut seat capacity by 2.2 percent. The region's total freight activity continues to struggle, posting its largest loss of 2019 (-11.2 percent/-23,601 tons). As in previous months, the international sector (over 60 percent of our region's total freight) led the decline (-15.3 percent/-20,423 tons). Domestic cargo recorded its third consecutive fall (-4.2 percent/-3,178 tons).
