With a growth rate of 1.6 percent, October registered the second weakest monthly percentage gain thus far this year. Nevertheless, it translated into another record-setting month as the region's total passenger traffic reached 10.9 million passengers – a net gain of 172,960 travelers. Growth was led by the international sector, which grew by 3.4 percent and set a new mark of 3.8 million passengers. The domestic sector, too, set a record of 7.2 million passengers, despite expanding by a mere 0.7 percent. Airlines grew their seat capacity by 2.9 percent, with domestic and international seats increasing by 1.9 and 5.3 percent, respectively. Following two consecutive months of solid growth, the region's total cargo activity registered a relatively modest 2.3 percent increase. International freight recorded a 5.2 percent increase. Domestic cargo landed in negative territory for the fourth time in 2016 as it fell by 3.1 percent.
