



Governor Murphy Takes Action on Legislation

TRENTON – In his final act in office, Governor Murphy has signed the following bills into law:

S-199/A-2308 (Smith/Swain, Danielsen, Haider) - Requires environmental sustainability plan for State House Complex

SCS for S-699/ACS for A-682 (Singer, Burzichelli/S. Kean, Fantasia, Bailey) - Establishes program in SADC for acquisition of development easements on privately-owned woodlands

S-877/A-3393 (A.M. Bucco, Pennacchio/Barranco, McGuckin, Bailey) - Exempts municipal electric utilities from regulation by BPU in certain circumstances

S-1016wGR/A-3636 (Greenstein, Beach/Murphy, Quijano, McCoy) - Requires State agencies to make their websites accessible to people with disabilities and on mobile devices

SCS for S-1029/ACS for A-4137 (Greenstein, Smith/Calabrese, Atkins) - "Invasive Species Management Act"; prohibits sale, distribution, import, export, and propagation of certain invasive species; establishes NJ Invasive Species Council

S-1385/A-3731 (Singleton, Amato/Murphy) - Establishes four-year pilot program in Ocean County for electronic monitoring of certain domestic violence offenders; appropriates \$2.5 million

S-1458/A-2138 (Lagana, Gopal/Moen, Danielsen, Karabinchak) - Requires Commissioner of Department of Veterans Affairs to develop mobile application to provide guidance on available resources to veterans and their families

S-1487/A-5625 (Turner, Wimberly/Reynolds-Jackson, Carter) - Requires application option enhancement for certain housing, shelter, and rental assistance administered by DCA

S-1965/A-588 (Vitale, Singer/Stanley, Atkins, Sampson) - Regulates provision of pharmaceutical services in long-term care facilities

S-2160/A-4860 (Sarlo, Greenstein/Calabrese, Danielsen, Quijano) - Allows seasonal retail consumption alcoholic beverage license holder to exchange license for full-year consumption license

SCS for S-2283/ACS for A-3852 (Scutari, Vitale/Calabrese, Verrelli) - Establishes Psilocybin Behavioral Health Access and Therapy Pilot Program; appropriates \$6 million

S-2346/A-2258 (Turner, McKnight/Lopez, McCoy) - Creates Code Red alert pilot program to shelter at-risk individuals during certain hot weather and air quality events; appropriates \$2.5 million

S-3195/A-5157 (Smith, Mukherji/Collazos-Gill, Donlon, Haider) - Prohibits food service business from providing single-use utensils and condiments to customers under certain circumstances and requires DEP to establish education campaign on benefits of reducing single-use utensils and condiments

S-3278wGR/ACS for A-4280 (Singleton/Calabrese) - Extends permission to administer glucagon and blood glucose tests to EMTs

S-3389wGR/A-4460 (Diegnan, Mukherji/Calabrese, Karabinchak, Park) - Provides certain requirements concerning railroad safety

S-3447/A-4607 (Corrado, Diegnan/Barlas, DePhillips, Stanley) - Establishes Special Education Transportation Task Force

S-3455wGR/A-4597 (Sarlo, Burzichelli/Calabrese, Moen, Stanley) - Provides for automatic renewal of off-track wagering licenses

S-3470/A-4674 (Stack, Steinhardt/Rodriguez, Park, Bagolie) - Upgrades cyber-harassment of public servant or family member to third degree crime; requires Attorney General to establish cyber-harassment prevention initiatives; appropriates funds

S-3517/A-4604 (Greenstein, A.M. Bucco, Sarlo/DeAngelo, Stanley) - Expands Division of State Police rank and grade titles

S-3530/A-4694 (Cruz-Perez, Ruiz, Greenstein/Lopez, Hall, Reynolds-Jackson, Sumter) - Establishes "Incarcerated Women's Protection Act" and concerns correctional facility board of trustees

S-3607/A-4748 (Sarlo, Cryan/Quijano, DeAngelo, Bagolie) - Extends accidental death benefit for survivors of certain SPRS retirees

S-3800/A-5048 (Johnson, Cruz-Perez/Katz, Peterpaul, Tucker) - Enhances protections under Law Against Discrimination for persons serving in military and military veterans

S-3802/A-5394 (Smith, McKeon/Venezia, Kennedy) - Requires certain State-funded construction projects to utilize plastic construction materials that contain certain amounts of postconsumer recycled content

S-3889/A-5387 (Ruiz, Turner/Moen, Carter) - Requires each public institution of higher education to develop food waste reduction program on campus

S-3906/A-5012 (Sarlo, Lagana/Sauickie, Calabrese, Scharfenberger) - Revises "Tree Experts and Tree Care Operators Licensing Act" to provide enforcement and penalty provisions

S-3993/A-5591 (Gopal/Peterpaul) - Changes certain requirements for inspection of records of motor vehicle sales

S-4010/A-5212 (Zwicker, Cryan/Simmons, Donlon, Swain) - Provides for expansion of social services supports at county colleges

S-4135/A-5470 (Mukherji, Turner/Pintor Marin, Morales) - Provides allowances for certain redevelopment projects undertaken by institutions of higher education under New Jersey Aspire Program

S-4219/A-5371 (Mukherji/Sampson, McCoy, Ramirez) - Concerns administration of employer payroll tax and requires disclosures of certain State taxpayer information

S-4387/A-5715 (Lagana, Beach/Stanley) - Requires establishment of tracking system in Division of Consumer Affairs to determine compliance with continuing education requirements

S-4510/A-5761 (Lagana, Scutari/Carter) - Clarifies procedures in certain contested child custody cases

S-4678wGR/A-5930 (Gopal, Mukherji/Swain, Reynolds-Jackson) - Includes retired teachers and county college faculty members in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics teacher grant program

S-4733/A-6039 (Johnson/Haider, Park) - Makes supplemental appropriation of \$45,000,000 from Transportation Trust Fund Account – Subaccount for Capital Reserves to Palisades Interstate Park Commission for certain construction projects

S-4812/A-6270 (Amato, Stack/Rumpf, Myhre) - Requires DCA to resume Reconstruction, Rehabilitation, Elevation and Mitigation program with remaining funds for unmet recovery and rebuilding needs for Superstorm Sandy-impacted homeowners

S-4816wGR/A-6119 (Vitale/Greenwald, Murphy) - Expands New Jersey's certificate of need exemption list

S-4831/A-6315 (Scutari/Swain) - Extends certain provisions of P.L.2021, c.498

S-4835/A-6073 (Sarlo/Calabrese, Park, Danielsen) - Allows voter to cure mail-in ballot due to certain envelope deficiencies or missing certificate, and to vote by provisional ballot following receipt of cure letter

S-4841/A-6105 (Moriarty/Hutchison, Miller) - Clarifies licensure requirements of home improvement and home elevation contractors

S-4845/A-6118 (Burzichelli, Testa/Greenwald) - Concerns Municipal Stabilization and Recovery Act; extends for six years

S-4847/A-6267 (Scutari/Atkins) - Makes various changes to membership on Cannabis Regulatory Commission and to legalized medical and personal use cannabis marketplace

S-4858/A-6000 (Gopal, Mukherji/Tucker, Murphy, Reynolds-Jackson) - Establishes "New Jersey Veterans and Military Spouses Asset Protection Act."

S-4864/A-5967 (Gopal, Singleton/DeAngelo, Verrelli, Egan) - Permits certain local units to enter into project labor agreements for public works projects below the \$5 million threshold

S-4870/A-5968 (McKnight, Ruiz/Lopez, Pintor Marin, Park) - Establishes new mitigating factor, reduced sentencing, and resentencing for certain defendants who are victims of abuse

S-4871/A-5969 (Ruiz, McKnight/Lopez, Pintor Marin, Park) - Provides expungement process for certain defendants who are victims of abuse if conviction is substantially related to abuse

S-4877/A-6179 (Smith, Turner/Karabinchak) - Modifies provisions concerning licenses for persons who transport, broker, or process solid waste or soil and fill recyclable materials

S-4879/A-5983 (Greenstein, Amato/DeAngelo, Drulis, Stanley) - Makes supplemental appropriation of \$3 million to NJ Division of State Police Internet Crimes Against Children Unit

S-4905/A-6202 (Greenstein, Mukherji/Danielsen) - Revises statutory definition of certain waterfront workers

S-4925/A-6268 (Sarlo/Swain, Tully) - Expands provisions of P.L.2022, c.9 under certain circumstances

S-4928/A-6237 (Sarlo, Diegnan/Greenwald, Simmons) - Requires payment of prevailing wage for certain data center construction

SCS for S-5015/ACS for A-6294 (Scutari/Calabrese) - Makes changes to how uniform gross receipts assessment are charged to ambulatory care facilities

S-5018/A-6292 (Zwicker/Drulis, Freiman) - Authorizes State Treasurer to sell as surplus certain real property and improvements in Township of Clinton in Hunterdon County

S-5021/A-6296 (Sarlo, Steinhardt/Greenwald, Dimaio) - Amends Fiscal Year 2026 annual appropriations act to expand authorized use of grant funding for Centenary University

S-5026/A-6302 (Stack, Turner/Rodriguez) - Allocates certain portion of appropriations made to New Jersey Schools Development Authority from "New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund"; appropriates \$3.25 million for certain high cost special education services

SJR-143/AJR-214 (McKnight, Wimberly/Reynolds-Jackson, Carter, Sampson) - Designates July 30 of each year as "Clarence 'Coach C' Collins Day"

A-1131wGR/S-3022 (Murphy, Matsikoudis/Singer, Amato) - Requires Department of Veterans Affairs to verify unclaimed cremains of veterans, spouses, and dependents; requires funeral director to report to Department of Veterans Affairs possession of unclaimed veteran, spouse, and dependent cremains

A-1400wGR/S-984 (Haider, Calabrese, Venezia/Greenstein, Turner) - Requires water supplier to notify affected municipalities, school districts, charter schools, nonpublic schools, and institutions of higher education of violations of drinking water quality standards

ACS for A-1921/S-4803 (Park, Quijano, Abdelaziz/Greenstein, McKnight) - Concerns AG guidelines on bias incident investigation standards

A-2115/S-2814 (Moen, Murphy, Stanley/Ruiz, Scutari) - Requires public transportation employees and certain motorbus operators to complete training course on handling and responding to suspected human trafficking; requires inclusion of certain content in certain courses

A-2415wGR/S-2802 (Quijano/Turner, McKnight) - Requires Silver Alert System receive same broadcast alerts as Amber Alert System

A-2801wGR/S-780 (Greenwald, Pintor Marin, Conaway/Johnson, Singer) - Renames, extends eligibility, and makes various other changes to Primary Care Practitioner Loan Redemption Program

A-2980wGR/S-4030 (McCoy/Gopal, Singleton) - Requires health care professionals to report cases of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and motor neuron disease

A-3036wGR/SCS for S-756 (Calabrese, Park, Haider/Johnson) - "Swift Access For Emergency Response Actions Preservation Program (SAFER APP)"; authorizes Attorney General to order turn-by-turn navigation systems to reroute vehicular traffic under certain conditions

A-3360/S-4832 (Carter, Quijano, Abdelaziz/Scutari, Singleton) - Authorizes establishment of municipal homelessness trust funds and adoption of homeless housing plans by municipalities

A-3739/S-3529 (Murphy, Rodriguez/Stack Bramnick) - Criminalizes the use of "signal jammers"

ACS for A-3753/SCS for S-3089 (Murphy, Quijano, Haider/Cryan, Singleton) - Concerns sexual assault forensic evidence kits

A-3941wGR/S-3071 (Freiman, Karabinchak/Greenstein, McKnight) - Changes classification of State Investigators in civil service

A-4101wGR/S-3017 (Drulis, Freiman, Speight/Zwicker, Sarlo) - Requires social media companies to establish toll-free telephone number for NJ account holders to report fraudulent account actions

A-4254/S-3280 (Carter, Wimberly, Reynolds-Jackson/Zwicker, Turner) - Establishes limits on transcript release restrictions at institutions of higher education and certain proprietary institutions

A-4284/S-3366 (Danielsen, Coughlin, Venezia/A.M. Bucco, Corrado) - Eliminates fee for special plates for firefighters and members of first aid or rescue squads

A-4302/S-3183 (Simmons, Tully, Stanley/Burzichelli, Mukherji) - Amends current child labor laws to protect minor working as vlogger in certain circumstances

A-4374/S-3187 (Carter, Lopez, Reynolds-Jackson/Cryan, Wimberly) - Establishes criminal penalties for certain violations of the "New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act"

A-4436/S-3323 (Karabinchak/Henry, Diegnan) - Requires local unit to accept electronic payment of construction code fees

A-4562/S-4554 (Bagolie, Freiman/McKeon) - Allows State, municipality, and county to implement automatic enrollment of their employees in deferred compensation plans

A-4618/S-3435 (Verrelli, Lopez, Calabrese/Cruz-Perez, Turner) - Requires official inspection facility employees covered by collective bargaining agreement to be offered employment following contract renewal or award of new contract; requires collective bargaining agreement to be binding in certain cases

A-4642wGR/S-3864 (Tully, Haider, Atkins/Lagana, Mukherji) - Allows certain individuals eligible for family support services to set aside unused agency-after school care service hours for use before official school hours and during official school closures under certain circumstances

A-4750/S-5006 (Murphy, Park/Johnson, Scutari) - Expands certain employer reporting requirements to include entities that employ or contract with individuals for financial compensation, including ride-sharing and delivery technology platforms

A-4973wGR/S-3913 (Bailey, Hutchison, Wimberly/Burzichelli, Moriarty) - "The Manufactured Home Park Protection Act"; expands opportunity to purchase for resident homeowners in certain manufactured home parks; modifies certain requirements for disposition of private residential leasehold communities

A-5901/S-4690 (Bailey, Karabinchak, DeAngelo/Burzychelli) - Authorizes certain energy projects involving installation of transmission and distribution wires that cross preserved farmland

A-5987/S-4860 (Peterpaul/Gopal) - Amends Fiscal Year 2026 annual appropriations act to reassign and clarify distribution of certain funds

A-6113/S-4998 (Sumter, Abdelaziz, McClellan/Wimberly) - Provides supplemental appropriation of \$4 million for Hinchliffe Stadium Partners to support stadium, entertainment, and tourism infrastructure at Paterson Great Falls National Park

A-6298/S-5025 (Greenwald, Simmons/Cruz-Perez, Diegnan) - Modifies provisions concerning net positive benefits test and special economic importance for certain transformative projects under New Jersey Aspire Program.
