SUBJECT: IRS/IEVS-WR535-01 Matched Records Report

As a result of the implementation of IEVS II, the IRS/IEVS-WR535-01 Matched Records Report has been restructured to include messages which are relevant to the history of the matched records appearing on the report. Indicated below are the six possible messages that may appear in the history field of the report along with brief explanations of their meanings.

IDENTICAL HIT OUTSTANDING

Previous hit, identical information, no response received by the State, FD-348 suppressed.

IDENTICAL HIT - RECHECK

Previous hit, identical information, response received by State indicating a "No Action Taken" choice of A, D1, D2, D4, or D5, new FD-348 generated.

IDENTICAL HIT - DISPOSITION ENTERED

Previous hit, identical information, response received by State indicating any "Action Taken" choice or a "No Action Taken" choice of B, C, D3, or D6, FD-348 suppressed.

HAD BEFORE - DIFFERENT ACCOUNT

Previous hit, identical information with the exception of a different account number and possibly a different account balance, new FD-348 generated.

HAD BEFORE - PRINCIPAL DIFFERENT


Previous hit, identical information with the exception of the estimated account principal which has increased from the previous hit by more than the 8% allowable gross interest, new FD-348 generated.

HAD BEFORE - WITHIN TOLERANCE

Previous hit, identical information with the exception of the estimated account principal which has not increased from the previous hit by more than the 8% allowable gross interest, FD-348 suppressed.
