**SUBJECT:** Safeguarding Internal Revenue Service Return Information Obtained through the Income and Eligibility Verification System

This communication serves to clarify Division policy concerning the proper handling and safeguarding of Internal Revenue Service (IRS) tax return data produced via the Income and Eligibility Verification System (IEVS).


The Division has recently received clarification from the Health Care Financing Administration concerning the safeguarding of IRS data once that information has been independently verified. For the purpose of this communication, IRS return information shall be defined as any data received by, recorded by, prepared by, furnished to, or collected by the IRS, and which has been supplied through IEVS.

Information that has been received through independent verification as a result of an IRS IEVS hit is not considered IRS return information and is therefore not subject to safeguarding procedures. However, verification does not negate the requirement to safeguard the original IRS data.

Therefore, notification forms such as the Form LD-141, IEVS client notification letter, and the PA-925, VIMS Resource Report, must continue to be safeguarded even after verification takes place. Strict safeguarding practices of such information must be adhered to in order to ensure appropriate handling of verified IRS return information.
