

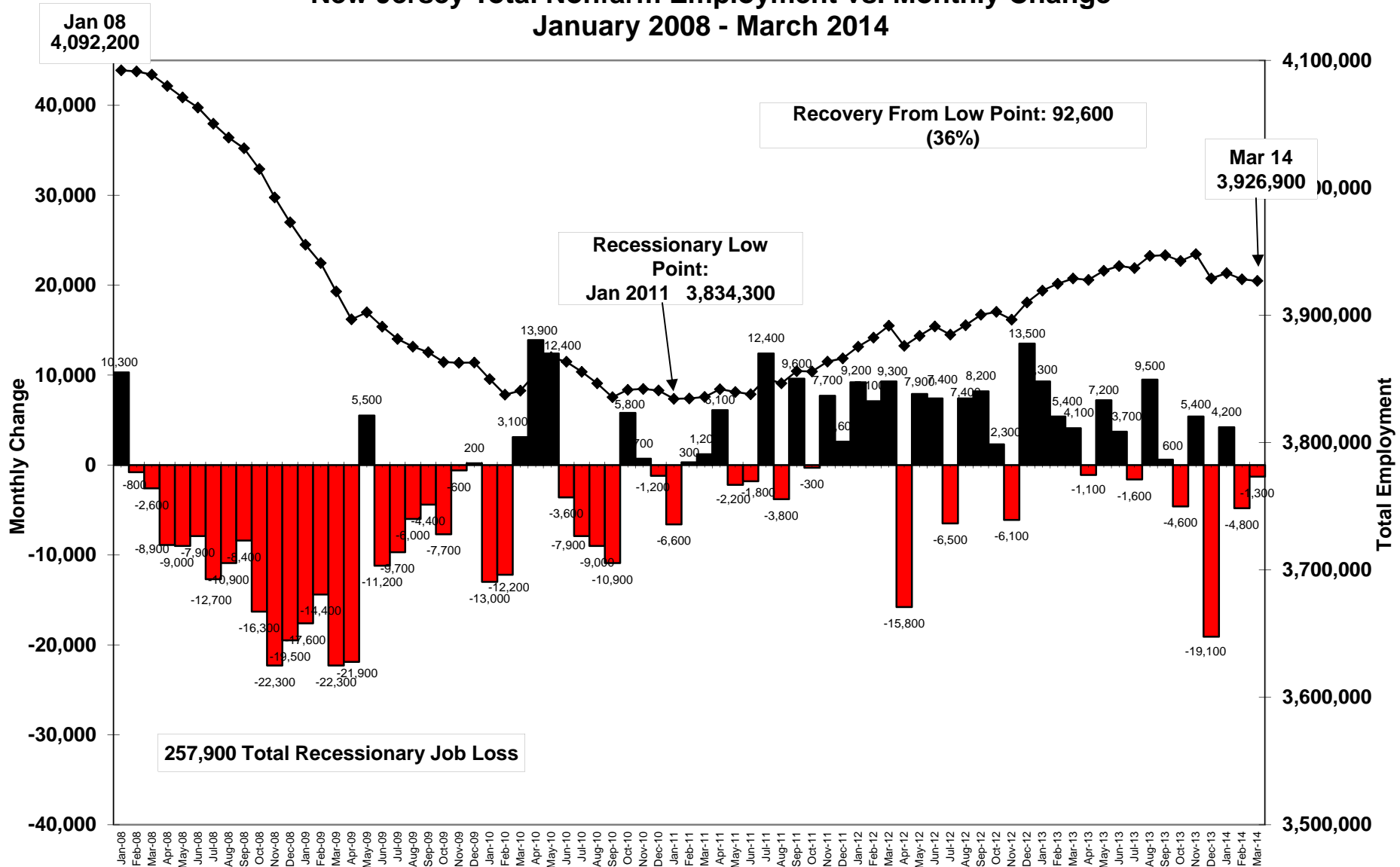

New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - March 2014



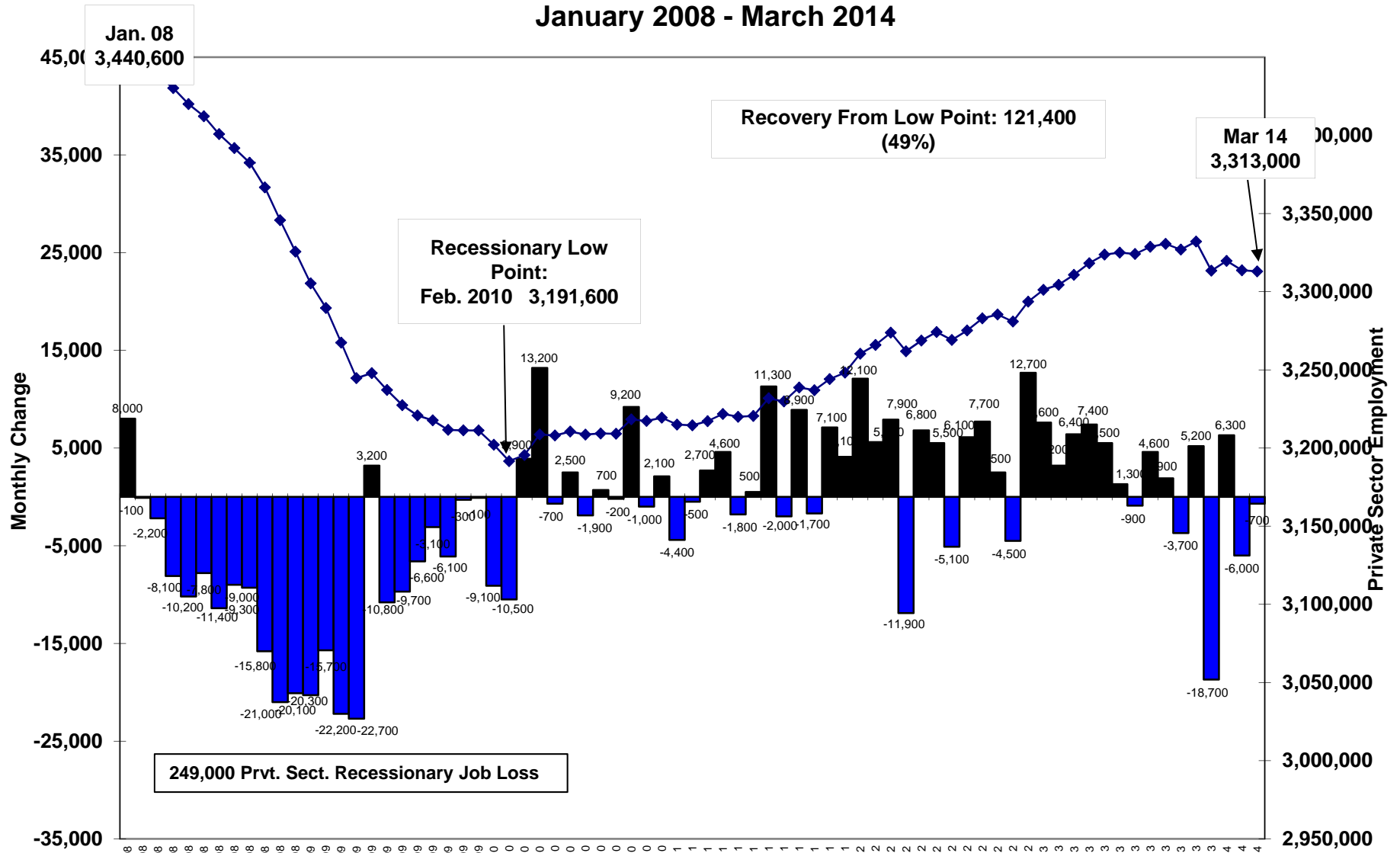

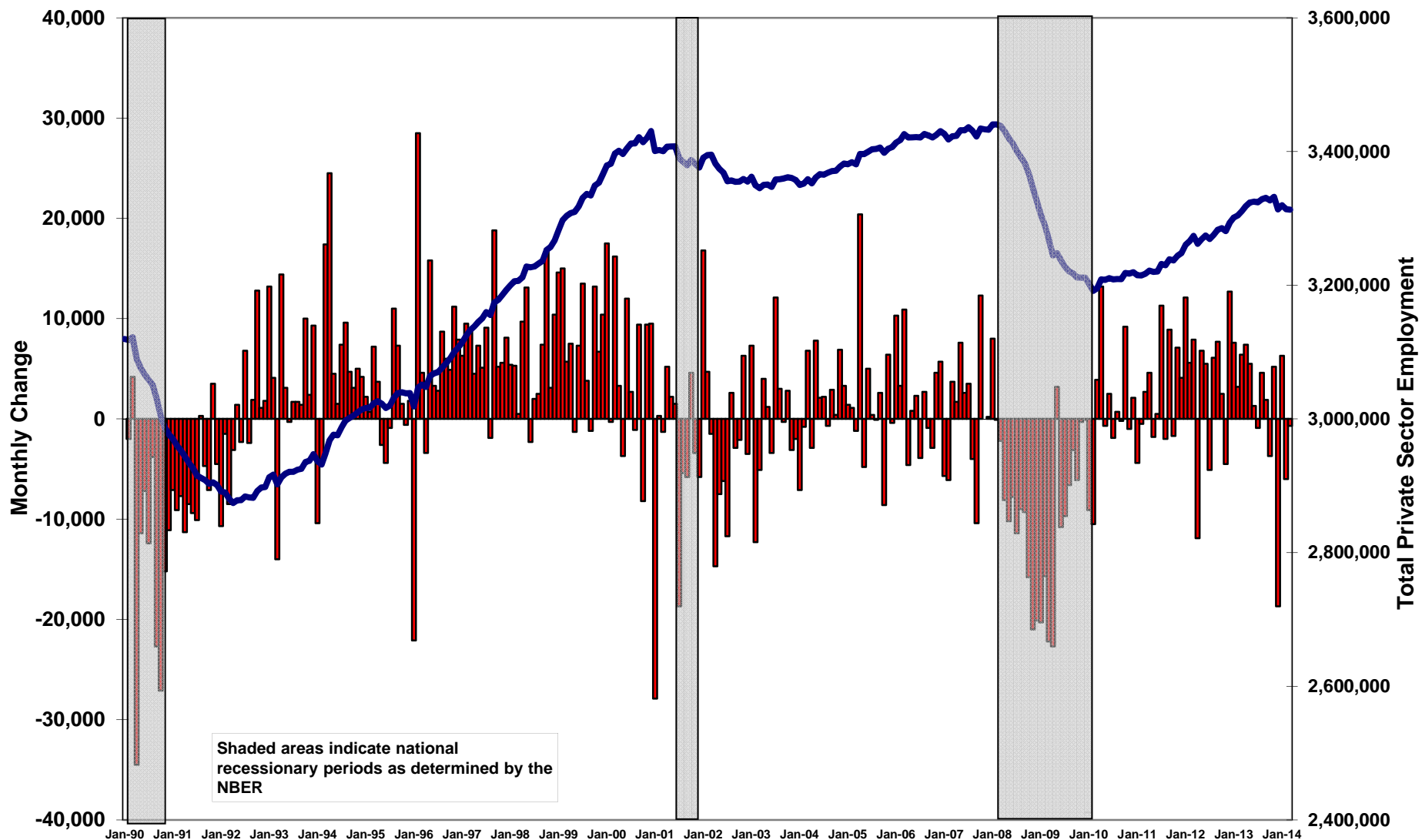

New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - March 2014

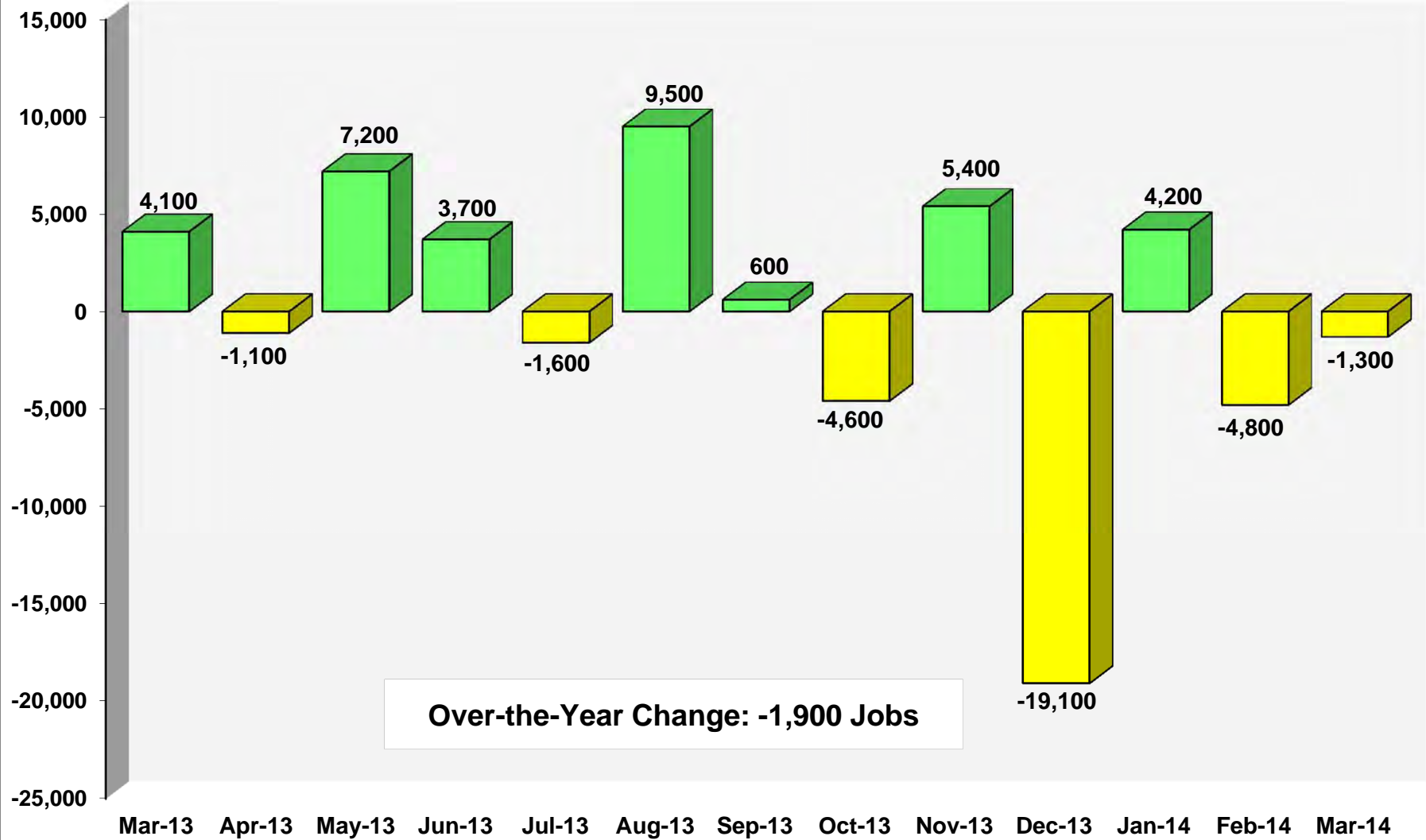

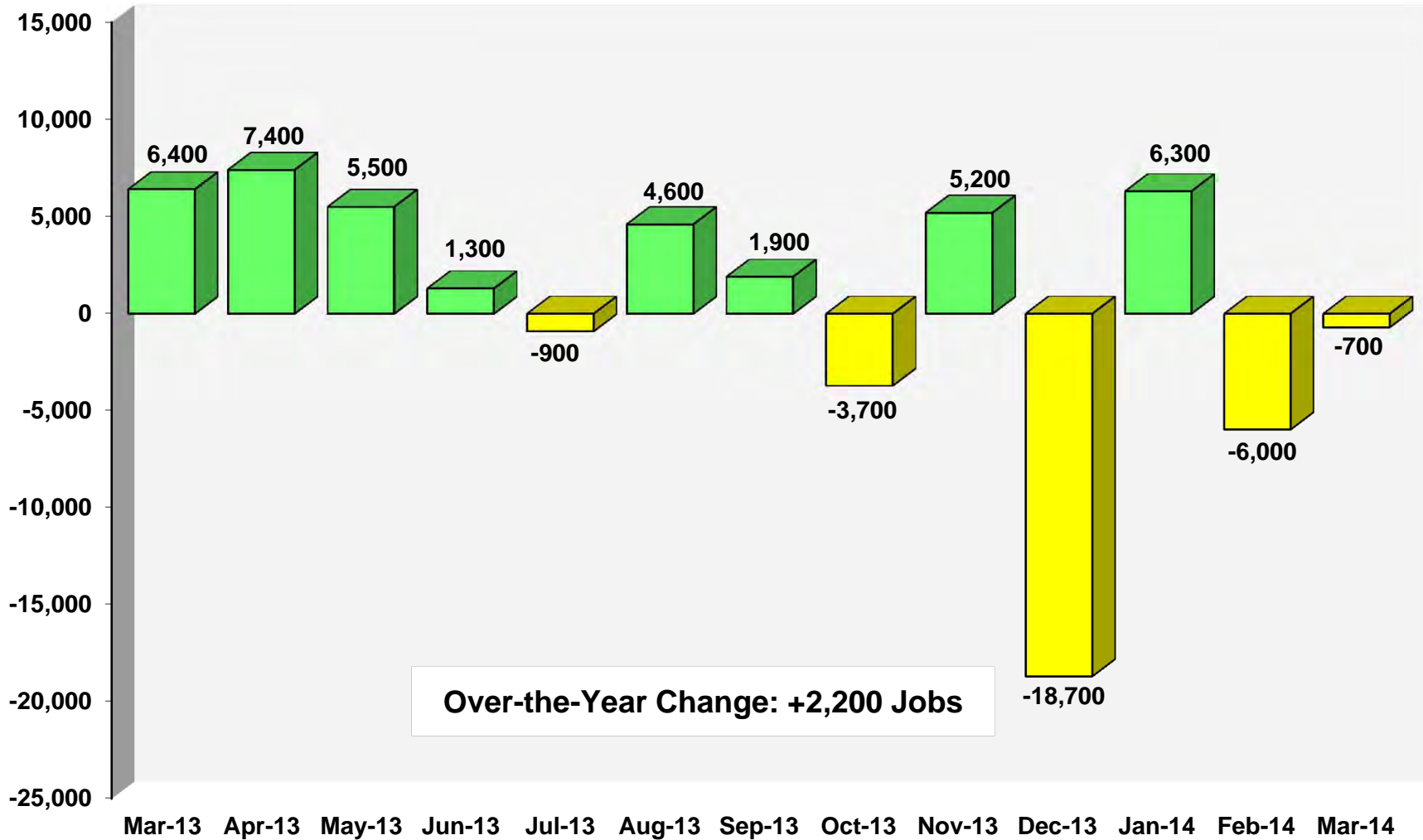
New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 1990 - March 2014



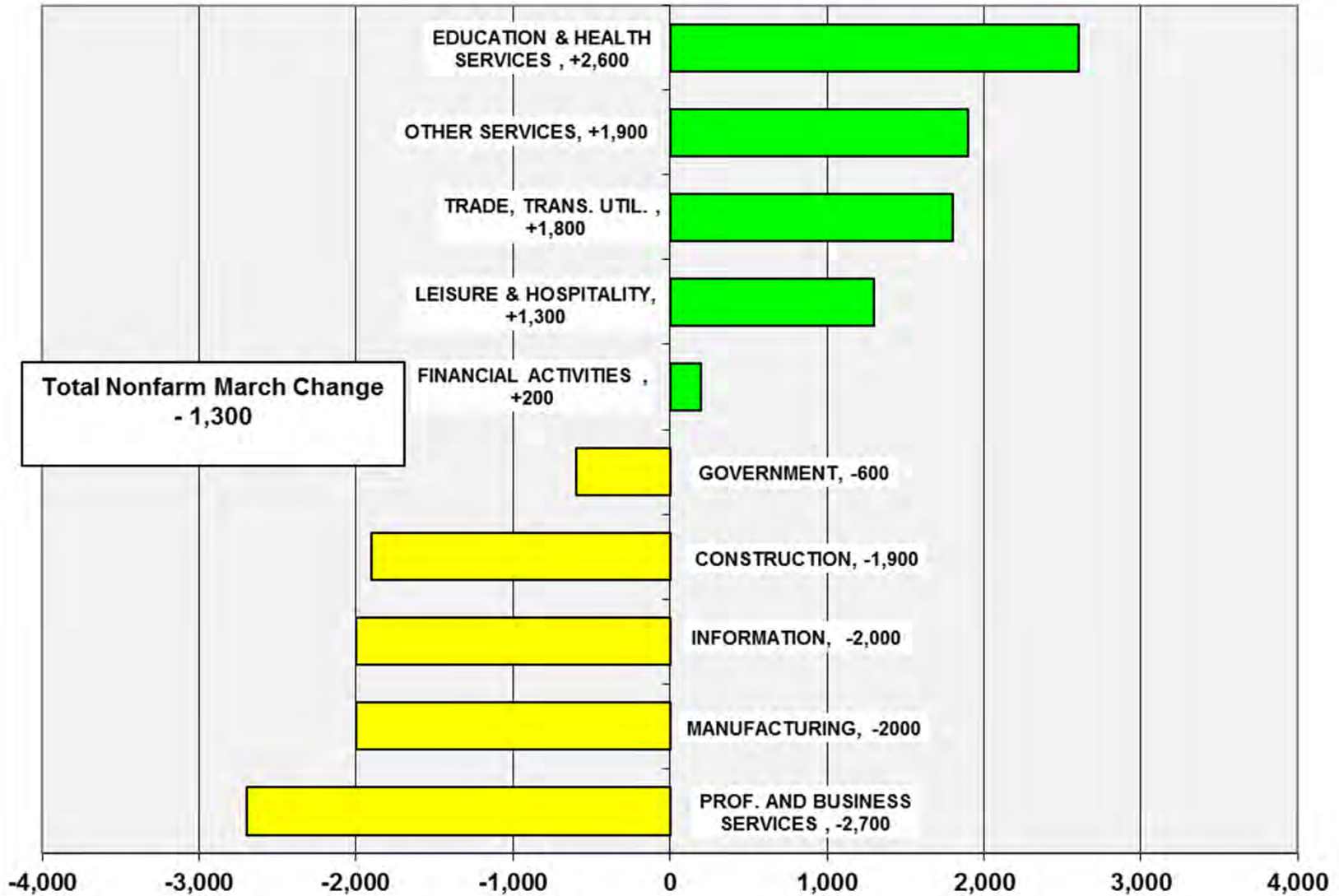
Monthly Total Employment Change New Jersey: March 2013 - March 2014



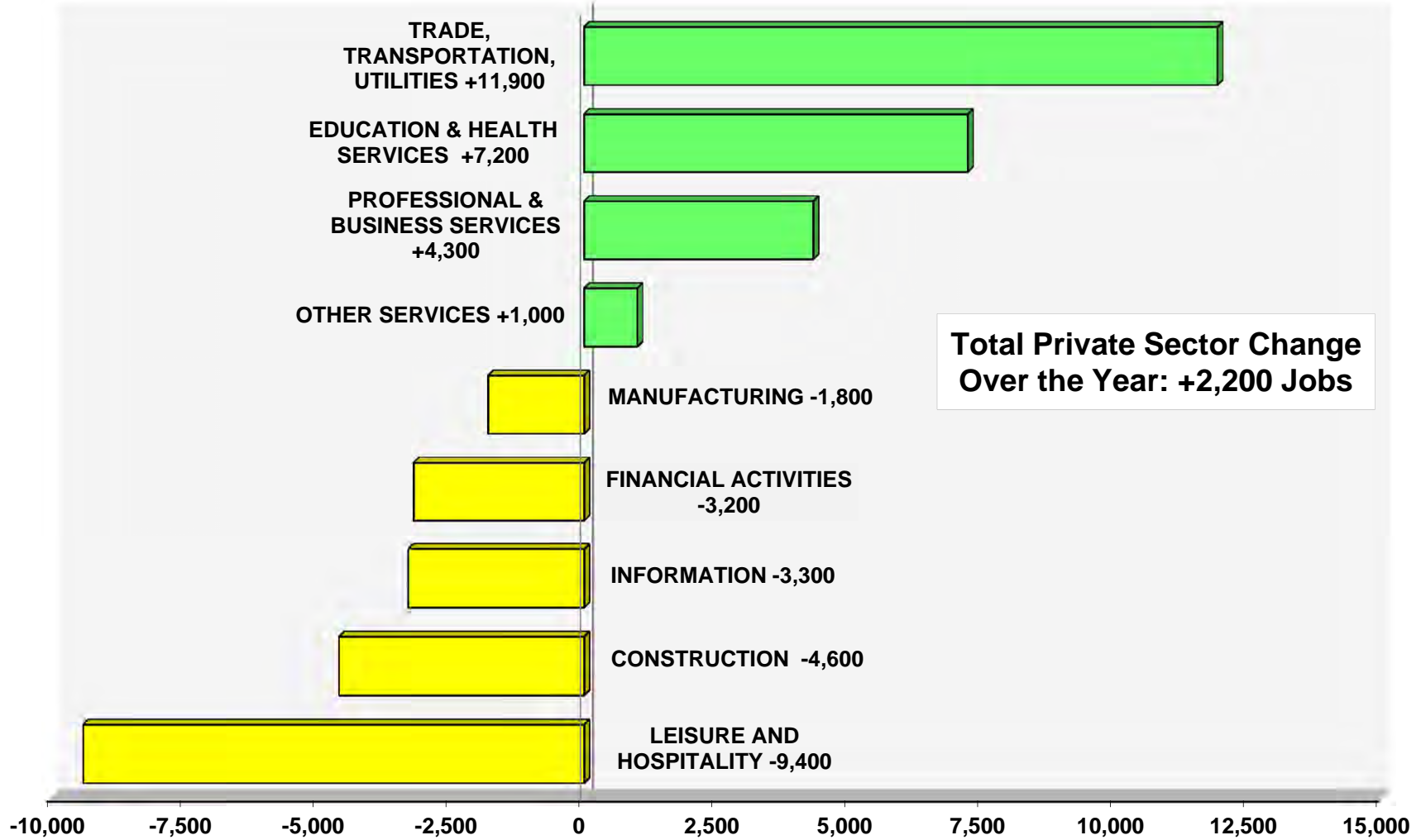
Monthly Private Sector Employment Change March 2013 - March 2014



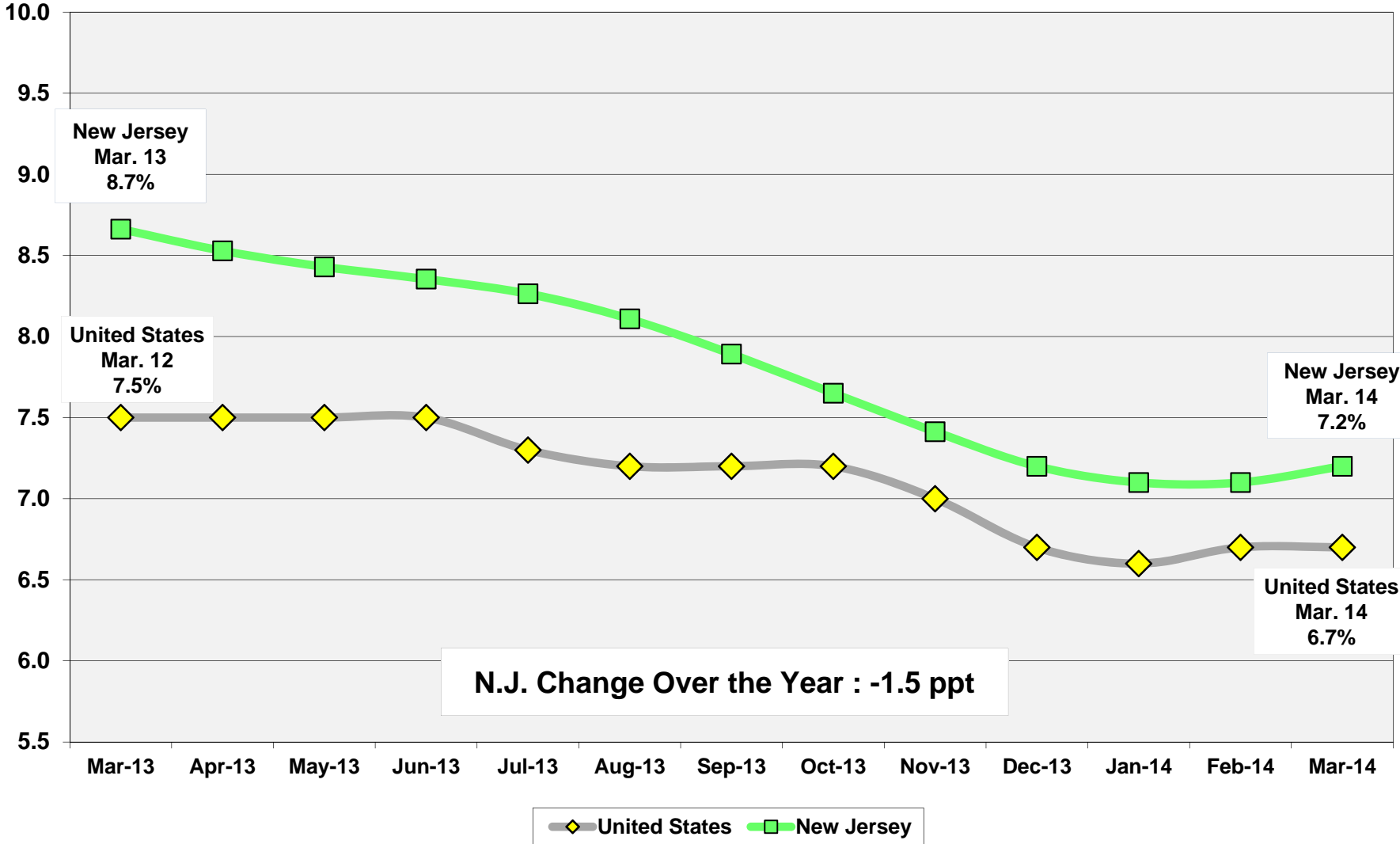

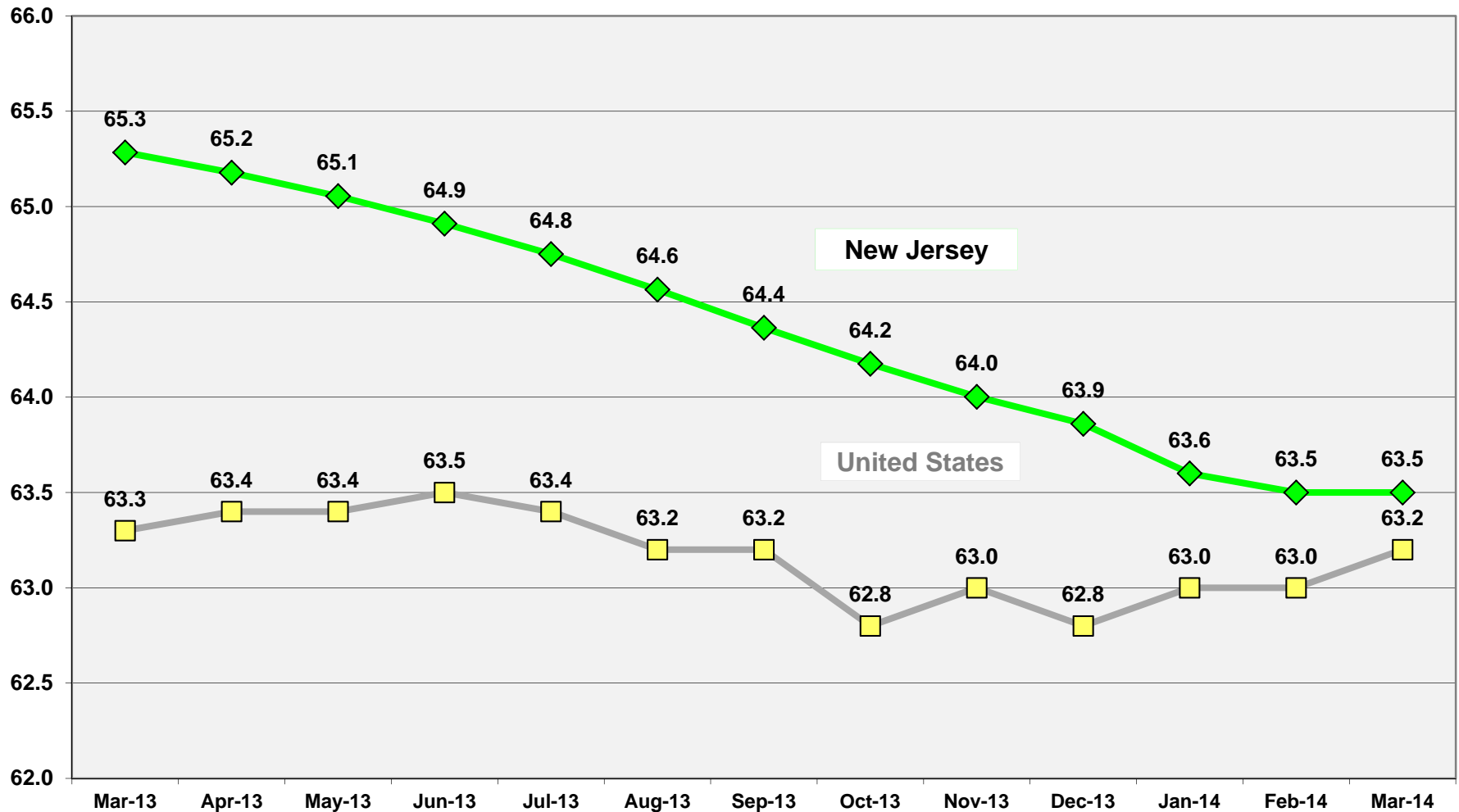
New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry March 2013 - March 2014



Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States: March 2013 - March 2014



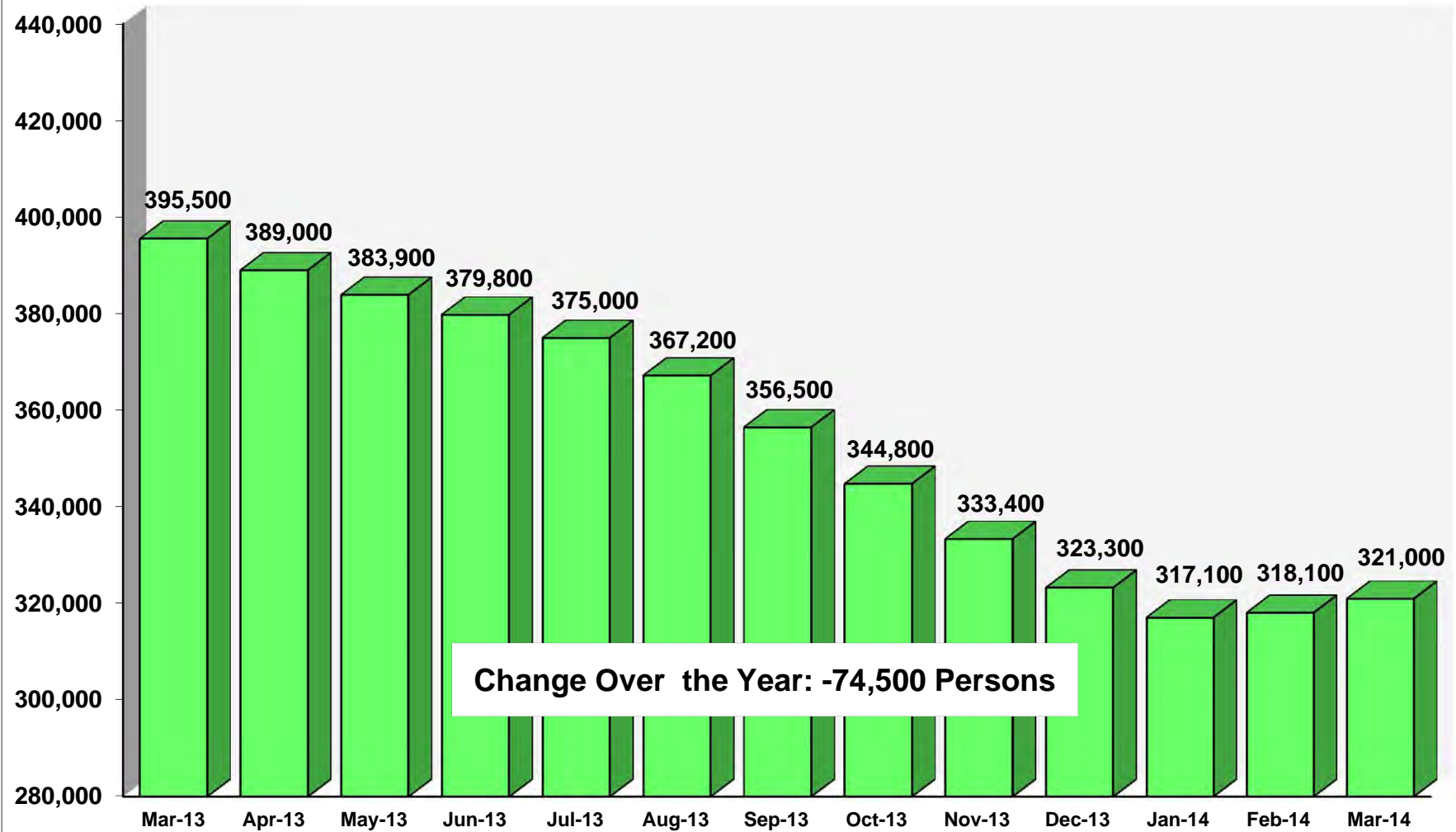
New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: March 2013 - March 2014



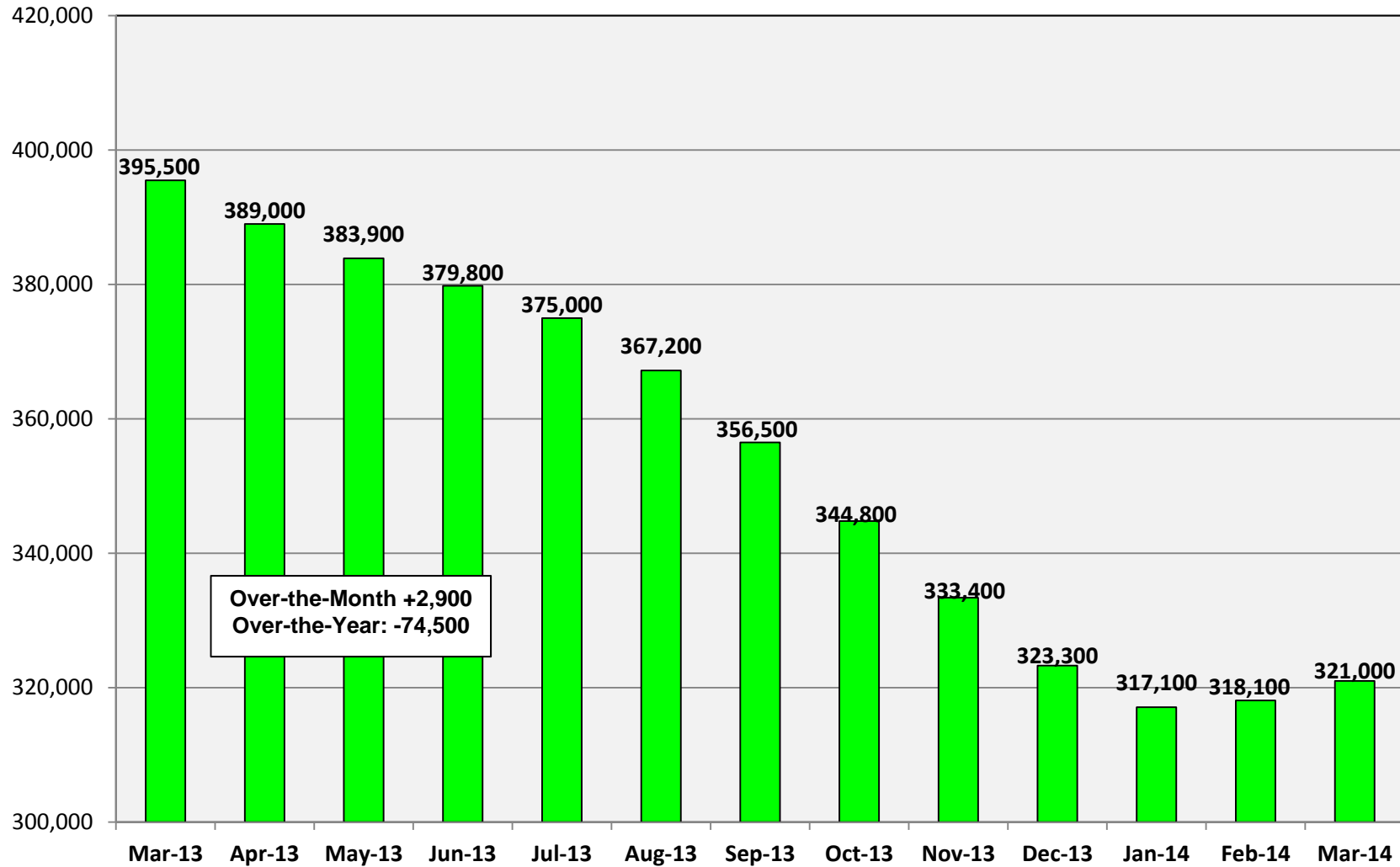
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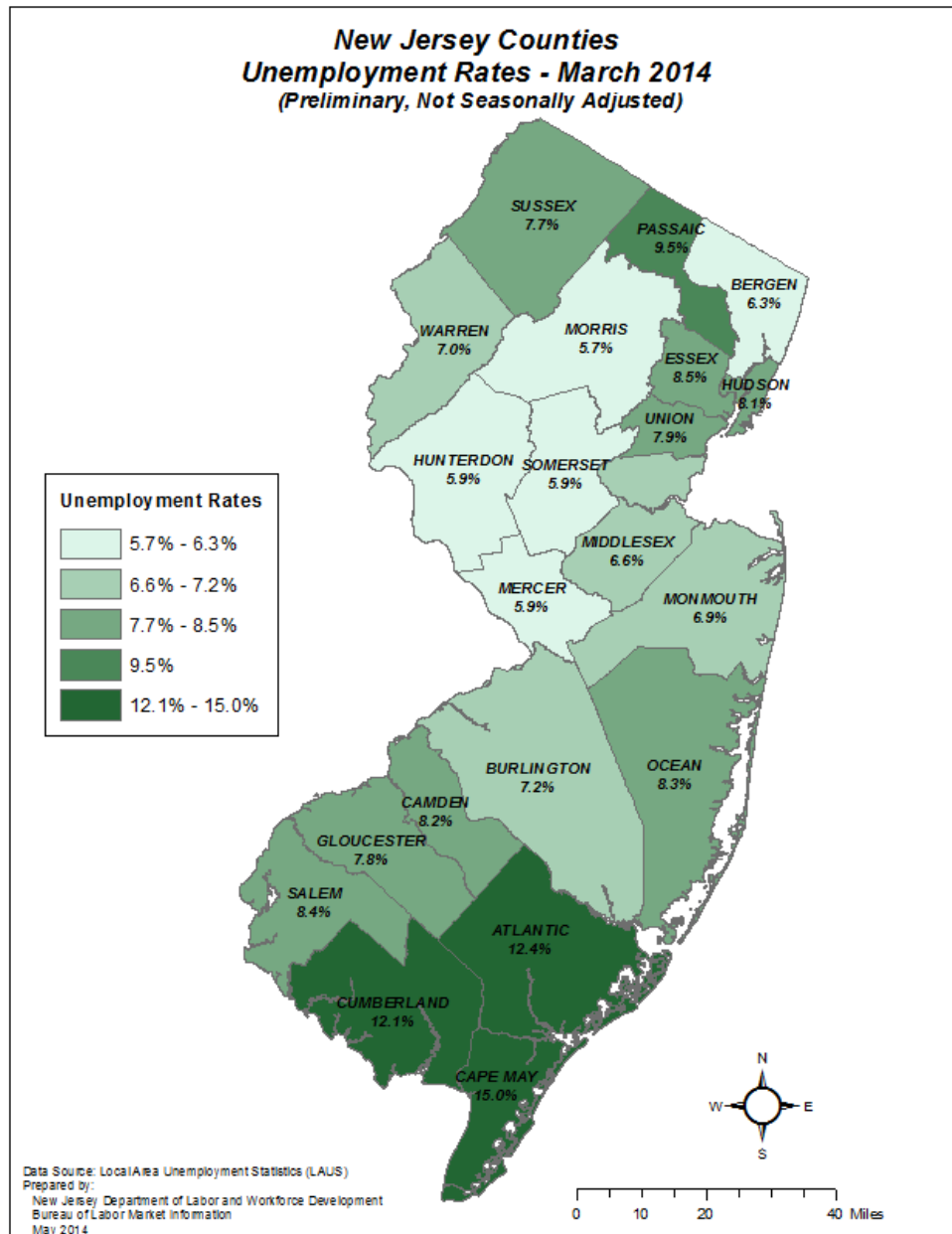
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Unemployed New Jersey Residents March 2013 - March 2014



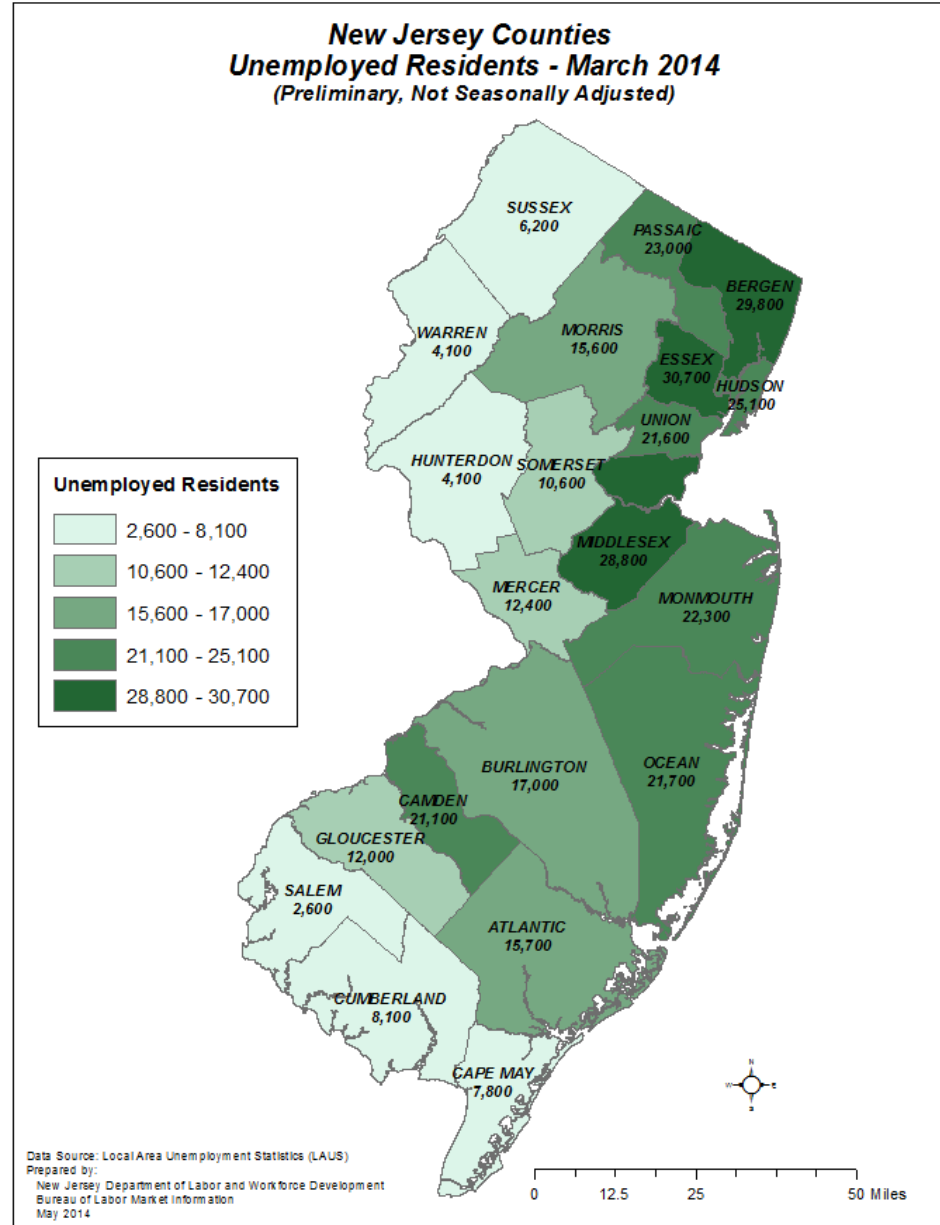
New Jersey Unemployed Residents: March 2013 - March 2014





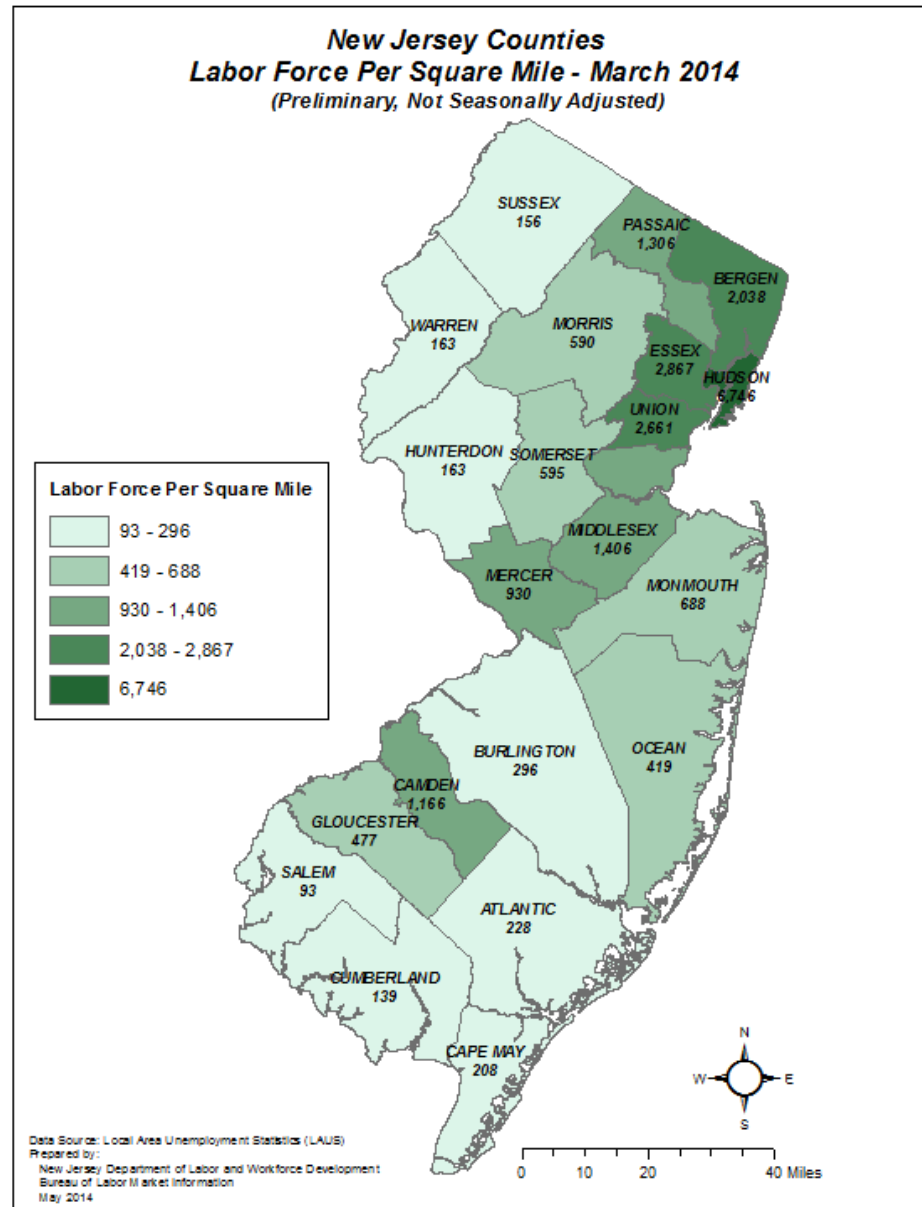
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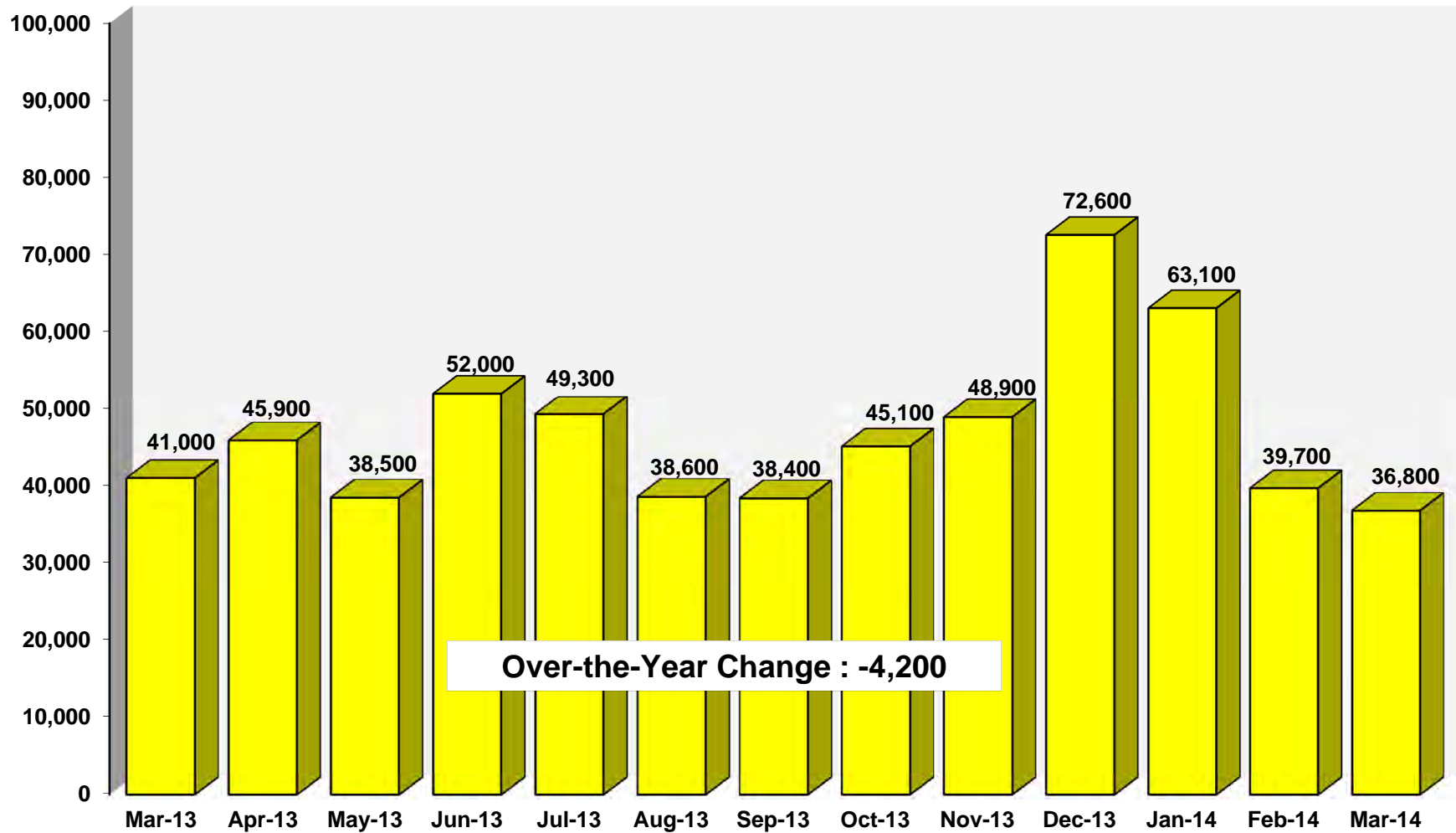
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New Jersey Monthly Initial Unemployment Claims March 2013 - March 2014

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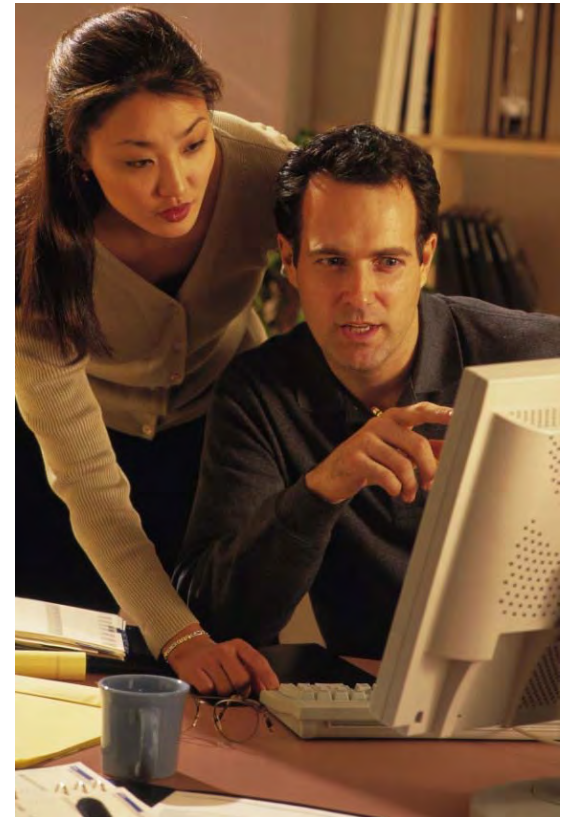
