The region's total passenger traffic had a best-ever month of April with 11.879 million air travelers (+360,290 passengers/+3.1 percent). The international sector set the tempo with a record 4.266 million passengers (+214,452 travelers/+5.3 percent). Domestic passenger volume also hit a new mark of 7.613 million passengers (+145,838 travelers/+2 percent). Airlines grew their total seat capacity by 1.3 percent. International seats set the pace with a 3 percent gain; domestic seats edged up 0.4 percent. Cargo's negative trend continued, as the region's total freight volume fell by 4.5 percent (-8,254 tons). The international sector (about 63 percent of our region's total), led the decline with an 11 percent plunge (-13,342 tons), as it posted its six straight monthly fall. In contrast, domestic cargo achieved its third-highest growth rate of the past 12 months (+8 percent/+5,087 tons).
