Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

Regional passenger traffic rose 2.1 percent in February after declining 1.2 percent in January. Surprisingly, domestic traffic grew faster than international, gaining 2.3 percent compared to international growth of 1.8 percent. The good news: In spite of the February storms, high fuel costs, flight cancellations, nearly 12 percent increase in domestic and international ticket prices, projected cuts in seat capacity and turmoil in the Middle East, our region's overall February seat capacity grew nearly 3 percent and passenger traffic grew in both the domestic and international markets. Cargo grew 6.7%.
