Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The region's passenger traffic continued its record growth pace as August traffic rose 5.2%, setting a new mark for our best August ever. Our airports served 12 million passengers, or 550,000 more than we handled in August 2014. The gains translate to year-to-date growth of 5.4%, or about 4.2 million passengers higher than the same period last year. Unlike previous months, international traffic set the pace, as it rose 5.2%. Domestic traffic was up 5.2%.: The region is on track for another record-breaking year, and year-end growth likely will be higher than the predicted 2.5%. Excluding April, the region's monthly cargo growth rate has progressively fallen after peaking in February, so it's no surprise that we turned negative in August, down 1.7% against August 2014.
