Press Advisory-Time Running Out For New Jersey 9/11 Responders to Register for Federal Workers' Compensation to Remain Eligible for Future Benefits

8/14/07 Registration deadline for compensation for NJ 9/11 responders

Thousands of New Jerseyans were involved in rescue, recovery or cleanup work after the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center on 9/11/01. On Wednesday June 6, New Jersey's Commissioners of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development and the Department of Health and Senior Services, together with New Jersey State Legislators, will hold a press conference to remind New Jersey 9/11 responders of the registration deadline for federally funded workers' compensation benefits.

Exchange Place: Foot of Montgomery Street at Hudson River in Jersey City Served by Newark-World Trade Center and Hoboken-World Trade Center lines

From NJ Turnpike I 95 and I 78 in the Newark Liberty Airport area, follow signs for I 78 Holland Tunnel. Travel on I 78 to Exit 14C. After paying toll, take the exit toward Jersey City/Columbus Drive, merge onto Center Street. Turn Right at Hudson Street for 217 feet and arrive at NJ Transit Path Exchange Place.

From US 1 and 9 follow signs for Holland Tunnel. Stay in right lane approaching Holland Tunnel tolls. US-1 9 N / US-1 & 9 N / US-1 N /

US-9 N becomes NJ-139 E. NJ-139 E becomes 12th St. Turn right onto Marin Blvd. Turn left onto Christopher Columbus Drive, follow this until it ends Path Exchange Station is to the right next to the Hyatt Hotel.
