The Board of Commissioners of the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioners ("PVSC") continues to resist the efforts of this Administration to undertake reform in accordance with sound ethical and fiscal practices. In light of your continued resistance, and because the Governor lacks veto authority over the actions taken by the Commissioners, I hereby demand that you produce the following information by the close of business next Tuesday, January 25, 2011:

1. A list of any and all individuals that you have identified, selected or recommended for hire to PVSC during the entirety of your service as a Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioner, including a statement of the reasons and justifications for those employment actions and the qualifications of the individuals recommended or selected for hire.
2. A list of any and all family members or relatives, including individuals related to you by blood or marriage, who have been or currently are employed by PVSC or are on the PVSC payroll. Indicate the nature of your involvement, if any, in the hiring decisions for your relatives, including but not limited to whether you recommended or supported such hiring either verbally or in writing. Provide the qualifications of your relatives who have been or currently are employed by PVSC.
3. Indicate whether any of the above-identified employees of PVSC, including both current and former employees, have received any salary increase, promotion, transfer or other benefit or "perk" not enumerated herein. Further indicate the justification for such action and the nature of your involvement, if any, in such action, including but not limited to whether you recommended or supported such action either verbally or in writing.
4. A list of any and all individuals or companies that have received compensation from PVSC, including but not limited to outside consultants or vendors, based upon your

recommendation or support. Provide a statement of the reasons and justifications for your recommendations and the qualifications of the individuals or companies recommended or selected. Indicate whether you possessed any interest, either direct or indirect, in any contract awarded.

We anticipate your prompt compliance.




