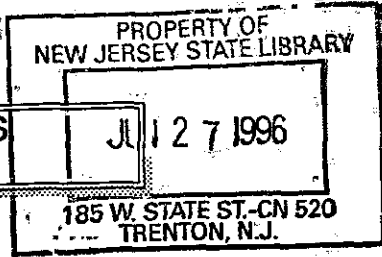

**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
MAY 1996**

Comparing counts for May 31, 1996 with those on May 31, 1995, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 11% increase from 25,354 to 28,124 for all institutions;
- 10% increase from 24,717 to 27,257 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting; county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 30% increase from 3,623 to 4,699 for county waiting;
- 10% increase from 940 to 1034 for county contract and county assistance;
- 7% increase from 14,942 to 16,010 for the prison complex;
- 6% increase from 5,212 to 5,514 for the youth facilities; and
- 36% increase from 637 to 867 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 14% increase from 1,418 to 1,612 for total admissions;
- 11% increase from 1,324 to 1,467 for adults; and
- 54% increase from 94 to 145 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 29% increase from 1,232 to 1,588 for total releases;
- 33% increase from 832 to 1,103 for adult male parole releases;
- 121% increase from 68 to 150 for adult female parole releases;
- 39% increase from 900 to 1,253 for total adult parole releases;
- 7% increase from 249 to 267 for offenders discharged at max; and
- -18% decrease from 83 to 68 for juvenile releases.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
