**ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS**  
**OCTOBER 1993**

Compared to the trimester ending October 31, 1992 Parole Releases for trimester ending October 31, 1993 were:

- Down 32% from 1911 to 1294 for the Prison;
- Down 40% from 220 to 132 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility;
- Down 29% from 772 to 547 for the Youth Complex; and
- Up 33% from 161 to 108 for Juvenile Facilities.

Resident counts on October 31, 1993 compared to the end of October 31, 1992 were:

- Up 3% from 22,542 to 23,237 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Up 8% from 3111 to 3363 for County Waiting;
- Up 3% from 23,145 to 23,863 for all Institutions;
- Up 1% from 13,995 to 14,096 for the Prison;
- Up 5% from 4596 to 4847 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Up 4% from 569 to 589 for Juvenile Facilities.

**NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ **PAROLE RELEASES** are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ **MEDIUM/MAX UNITS:** Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
