ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS

Compared to the trimester ending June 30, 1993 Releases for trimester ending June 30, 1994:

- Up 27% from 2277 to 2896 for the Prison;
- Up 34% from 154 to 207 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility
- Up 13% from 678 to 768 for Youth Facilities, and
- Up 11% from 103 to 114 for the Juvenile Complex.

Resident counts on June 30, 1994 compared to the end of June 30, 1993 were:

- Up 7% from 22,459 to 23,956 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Up 15% from 2979 to 3440 for County Waiting;
- Up 7% from 23,050 to 24,595 for all Institutions;
- Up 6% from 13,849 to 14,666 for the Prison;
- Up 3% from 4778 to 4933 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Up 6% from 575 to 609 for Juvenile Facilities.

NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ PAROLE RELEASES are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ MEDIUM/MAX UNITS: Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
