Compared to the trimester ending March 31, 1994 Admissions for trimester ending March 31, 1995:

- Up 25% from 2601 to 3246 for the Prison;
- Up 45% from 198 to 288 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility
- Down 54% from 65 to 30 for Youth Facilities, and
- Down 1% from 295 to 292 for the Juvenile Complex.

Resident counts on March 31, 1995 compared to the end of March 31, 1994 were:

- Up 7% from 23,068 to 24,586 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Down 11% from 4081 to 3647 for County Waiting;
- Up 2% from 24,700 to 25,243 for all Institutions;
- Up 5% from 14,187 to 14,883 for the Prison;
- Up 5% from 4869 to 5112 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Down 3% from 609 to 589 for the Juvenile Facilities.

NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ PAROLE RELEASES are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ MEDIUM/MAX UNITS: Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
