## A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

## OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

### I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### II. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to water-front construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 0700, or (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallorage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

## MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

March 19--DEP RECOMMENDS TRUCK EMISSION INSPECTIONS--Noting that the average gasoline powered truck emits 27 percent more carbon monoxide and 55 percent more hydrocarbons than the average auto, DEP in a 46-page report to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Inspection System Study Commission urged adoption of a self-inspection program backed up by roadside spot checks of trucks. At present, heavy duty gasoline powered trucks and buses are exempt from the New Jersey exhaust emission testing program required for autos and light duty trucks. March 19--CAFRA PERMIT IN WEST LONG BRANCH--DEP has approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for a 21-acre, 64-unit subdivision adjacent to Orchard Road and Richard Lane in West Long Branch, Monmouth County. Approval for the project proposed by William Marshall Corporation of Oakhurst includes conditions for a revised drainage plan, a minimum 25-year storm design and an on-site retention basin.

March 19--\$1.1 MILLION IN SEWERAGE GRANTS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced awarding of eight sewerage grants totaling over \$1.1 million. They are: Ramsey, Bergen County, \$580,700 new wastewater collection system. Mahwah Township, Bergen County, \$432,020 wastewater collection system in northern area. Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission, Essex County, \$70,400 to study alternatives to ocean dumping of sludge. Northeast Monmouth County Regional Authority, \$7,600 to study alternatives to ocean dumping of sludge. Randolph Township Municipal Utilities Authority, Morris County, \$13,187 for wastewater collection system. Little Egg Harbor Municipal Utilities Authority, Ocean County, \$3,114 for planning for future construction of sewage collection system. Eagleswood Township, Ocean County, \$1,000 to plan for installing sewers to service areas along Route 9 and Bay Avenue waterfront area. Paterson, Passaic County, \$5,886 to plan for separation of sanitary sewage from storm water runoff which now enter the same pipes. The eight percent state grants come from clean water bond issues and are administered by DEP. The U.S. Environmental Protection Administration (EPA) will pay 75 percent of the total cost and the applicant will pay the remaining 17 percent.

March 20--O'HERN SPEAKER AT ANJEC CONFERENCE--DEP Commissioner Daniel J. O'Hern was keynote speaker at the ninth annual Commissioners Day of the Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions (ANJEC) March 21 in Trenton.

\* \* \*

March 21--GUIDELINES FOR WATERFRONT GROWTH--DEP issued eight basic policies recommended as guidelines for future growth in waterfront areas along the Hudson and Delaware rivers and their tributaries. They are in a report, "Options for New Jersey's Developed Coast," which is preliminary to a final segment of the state coastal management program. Extensive public hearings, meetings and workshops will be held later. Copies of the 70-page report are available from DEP's Office of Coastal Zone Management, Box 1889, Trenton, N.J. 08625.

March 21--FEDERAL GRANTS TO UPGRADE URBAN PARKS--Four counties and 21 municipalities in New Jersey are eligible for federal grants to improve recreational facilities under terms of the Urban Parks and Recreation Recovery Act of 1978. Officials of eligible counties and municipalities will be invited to an informational meeting in Trenton in May, according to DEP Deputy Commissioner Betty Wilson.

\* \* \*

March 21--RECYCLING WATER CONSERVATION FUND MONEY--Governor Byrne signed a bill appropriating nearly \$6 million in funds which have been repaid to the state from sewerage planning loans made earlier through the 1969 Water Conservation Fund. Under the measure sponsored by Senator Lawrence Weiss (D-Middlesex), \$5,238,574 will become available to provide the eight percent state match for local sewerage treatment projects. The bill also appropriates \$200,000 for design and engineering of a dam monitoring system for the Spruce Run/Round Valley reservoir complex, and \$562,000 to upgrade the sewage treatment plant at Ancora State Hospital.

\* \* \*

March 21--BYRNE SEEKS REGIONAL SULPHUR STANDARDS--Governor Byrne wrote to President Carter, urging a shift in rules for relaxation of sulphur-in-fuel standards, should it be necessary due to an oil shortage. Instead of relaxing the rules on a state-by-state basis, Byrne wrote, doing it on a regional basis could avert unfair, inefficient and even conflicting environmental and economic consequences. Regional standards would equalize the economic impacts on the states throughout the region and would minimize air pollution, he continued.

March 22--PINELANDS COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP COMPLETE--Governor Byrne named seven members of the Pinelands Planning Commission, under terms of the February 8 Executive Order No. 71. They are, Franklin Parker, Mendham, chairman; Peter J. Burke Jr., Williamstown; Floyd West, Bass River Township, Gary Patterson, Woodland Township; Thomas Darlington, New Lisbon; Candace Ashmun, Bedminster, and B. Budd Chavoosian, Trenton. One member each is named by freeholders in seven counties. They are, Freeholder Robert Shinn, Hainesport, Burlington County; Mayor Russell Clark, Hammonton, Atlantic County; Freeholder Donald H. Wagner, Woodbury, Gloucester County; Freeholder Hazel Gluck, Lakewood, Ocean County; Freeholder Anthony Catanoso, Wildwood, Cape May County, and County Environmental Commission Director Joan Batory, Haddonfield, Camden County. Mayor Patrick Fiorilli of Vineland will be named to represent Cumberland County, according to the county freeholders. The 15th member, appointed by the Secretary of the Interior to represent the federal government, is David F. Hales, deputy assistant Interior secretary for fish, wildlife and parks.

March 23--DEP WARNS OF FOREST FIRE SEASON--DEP alerted the public to dangers of forest fires during the March 15-May 15 period. The past week brought 90 fires which burned off a total of 250 acres, it was reported. The public was asked to exercise extra safeguards.

March 23--DEP REJECTS TWO PROPOSED WASTE FACILITIES--Application of Earthline, Inc., of Newark, to build and operate a hazardous waste disposal facility in Bordentown, Burlington County, was denied by DEP. Beatrice S. Tylutki, director of the Solid Waste Administration (SWA), said the proposal "does not meet state standards and goals." She said hazardous chemical wastes would threaten surrounding land uses, including a high school; the site would be out of step with statewide solid waste management planning, and the applicant failed to delineate specific wastes to be disposed of there. SWA also denied application of Buzby Resources, Inc., for the proposed White Horse Landfill in Voorhees Township, Camden County, as being unacceptable, with potential problems of noise, dust, methane gas migration, storm water discharge, odor and increased area traffic.

March 23--REVIEW BOARD GRANTS PINELANDS MORATORIUM EXEMPTIONS--The Pinelands Review Board granted building moratorium exemptions for five single-family homes, 12 subdivisions, a sewer line and a campground. Partial exemption, for 25 of 49 proposed houses, was granted to another subdivision. Rejected were a single-family home and a 37-lot subdivision. Exemptions allow for building a total of 583 single-family dwellings. The Review Board meets next Friday, March 30, at 9:30 a.m. in the Department of Agriculture, Trenton.
