In addition the circular provides a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings. (The Public Hearings however, are not official DEP notices). Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the week are also shown. Any additional information concerning the permits may be obtained by contacting the appropriate person listed below.

A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the <u>Governor's Executive Order # 57</u> the <u>Office of Business Advocacy</u> as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expediters in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to water-front construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NI 08625.

MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

April 16--NINE SITES ON HISTORIC REGISTER--Nine sites have been added to the State Register of Historic Places, and have been nominated for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, according to Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson. They are: Van Buskirk-Oakley House, Oradel, Bergen County; John Holmes House, Swainton, Cape May County; Hoboken Land and Improvement Company Building, Hoboken, Hudson County; Henry Clay and Bock and Company, Trenton, Mercer County; Gulick House, South Brunswick, Middlesex County; Cornelius Gunn House and Richard Layton House, both Walpack, Sussex County; Foster-Armstrong House, Montague, Sussex County; Washington Railroad Station, Washington, Warren County.

April 17--ONE CAFRA PERMIT DENIED, AMOTHER APPROVED--DEP's Division of Marine Services denied a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit sought by Sam and George Reider of Toms River for a 75-unit subdivision on 23 acres off Silver Bay Road and Brand Road in Dover Township, Ocean County. Donald T. Graham, division director, said part of the site is environmentally sensitive due to a stream and associated wetlands. He said the remaining 80 percent of the site could be developed, and the division is ready to work with the applicant to redesign the project. The division approved a CAFRA permit for construction of two motels in Wildwood Crest, Cape May County. Proposed by Wally Lerro, the projects consist of a 33-unit addition to the Four Winds Motel on Denver Avenue and a 21-unit motel on Syracuse Avenue at the beach. A \$1,000 fine was paid by the applicant prior to approval. It was imposed because construction began prior to receipt of the CAFRA approval.

April 17--THREE GREEN ACRES GRANTS TOTAL \$176,900--Acting Governor Thomas J. Deverin announced the award of three DEP-administered Green Acres matching grants. They are: \$81,500, Moorestown Township, Burlington County, to develop Stanwick Road Park; \$55,650, Clinton Township, Hunterdon County, to acquire 50 acres in Beaver Brook Ravine for passive recreation and protecting water quality, and \$39,750, Holmdel Township, Monmouth County, to acquire 16-acre Middle Road Park.

April 18--DEP GETS \$450,000 GRANT FROM EPA--DEP's toxic substances program, headed by Dr. Peter Preuss, will be expanded through a \$450,000 grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The money will finance a new investigative unit to identify and investigate toxic problems and solutions, and will enhance the air monitoring program by providing capability for broad spectrum analysis of volatile organics. It is one of the largest EPA grants distributed among the 50 states.

April 19--0'HERN UPHOLDS DENIAL BUT CALLS FOR BETTER ZONING--DEP Commissioner Daniel J. O'Hern upheld 1977 denials of riparian and wetlands permits sought by Loveladies Harbor, Inc., and Loveladies Harbor-Unit D, Inc., in order to build 108 single-family houses on 51 acres fronting on Barnegat Bay in Long Beach Island

Township, Ocean County. Noting that local zoning prohibits clustering of houses, O'Hern called for municipal governments throughout New Jersey to use more imagination in their zoning to meet demands for residential, commercial and recreational expansion while still preserving and protecting the environment."

April 19--DEP APPROVES GOLDEN NUGGET CAFRA PERMIT--DEP's Division of Marine Services has approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for the 520-roon Golden Nugget hotel-casino on Pacific Avenue and the Boardwalk in Atlantic City. The approval carries various conditions, including an employee shuttle bus, landscaping, proper wastewater collection, control of stormwater pollution, shorefront access, wider sidewalks and a limit on garage parking spaces.

April 19--DEP DAY TRIPS FOR YOUNGSTERS--DEP is accepting applications from youth-serving groups to participate in the Recreation Opportunity Project, which makes grants for transportation and camping to sponsoring agencies. The program is administered by DEP's Division of Parks and Forestry for youngsters aged 18 or under coming from low and moderate-income families. Day-trips will be to zoos, camping, swimming and hiking places and sporting events. Deadline for filing applications is May 4. April 19--INFORMATION MEETING ABOUT COOLING TOWERS--DEP's Division of Environmental Quality will hold an informational meeting April 25 at 7:30 p.m. in the Lower Alloways Creek Township School at Canton, about the application of Public Service Electric & Gas Co. to erect two 500-foot cooling towers at the future site of its Hope Creek Nuclear Generating Stations.

April 20--WATER SUPPLY MASTER PLAN MEETINGS --DEP announced five public meetings to gather data and recommendations for a statewide Water Supply Master Plan to cover the coming 30 or 40 years. The meetings, all at 7:30 p.m., are April 23, Vineland Municipal Building; April 24, Ocean County College, Toms River; April 25, Municipal Complex, Medford Lakes; April 26, Municipal Building, Hackettstown, and April 30, City Hall, East Orange.

April 20--PINELANDS BOARD APPROVES SCHOOLS, DWELLINGS--The Pinelands Development Review Board approved two public schools, in Egg Harbor and Tabernacle townships, and 31 single-family homes, for exemptions from temporary development restrictions in the Pinelands protection area. The Tabernacle approval is conditional on protection of water quality in Bread and Cheese Run downstream from the site. A hardship exemption, conditional on design standards to be defined by the DEP staff, was granted for a 57-lot subdivision in Shamong Township proposed by Joseph Bricketto. Referred to the Pinelands Planning Commission were applications by Waterford Township for a wastewater collection system and by M-E Enterprises for a 466-unit subdivision in Waterford and Winslow townships.
