A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expediters in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

L STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development. P.O. Box 1889. Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

ASSOCIATION OF NEW JERSEY ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSIONS

NEWARK — The Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions, (ANJEC), together with fifteen other New Jersey environmental groups, will be presenting the 6th annual New Jersey Environmental Congress on October 20th. The Congress, which will be held at the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) offers an opportunity for the state's diverse environmental community and interested citizens to review environmental goals, hear from governmental leaders as to New Jersey's program in the pursuit of a better quality of life, and to hear experts discuss solutions to environmental problems.

The focus of this year's congress will be the effective management and implementation in the 1980's of the environmental technology and regulation developed in the past decade.

U.S. Senator Bill Bradley has been invited to open the morning session to discuss the national perspective on environmental issues in the 1980's. N.J. Senator Joseph Merlino has been invited to provide the state's perspective and Newark Mayor Kenneth Gibson, the local perspective. DEP Commissioner Jerry English has also been invited to address the environmental community. A question and answer session will follow.

Six concurrent seminars will analyze specific strategies for environmental action in the afternoon session. Participants will be asked to develop a list of legislative and administrative recommendations to submit to Governor Byrne and the appropriate agency.

Local Decisions in Water: Protection of Demand?
Solid Waste: New Jersey's Only Increasing Resource
Transportation Planning, A Vehicle for Clear Air
Some Call it Lobbying: How to Affect Legislation and Regulation

Saving the Back Forty: Farmland Preservation in the 1980's

Urban Land Use Planning: The Citizen's Role

A cafeteria lunch will be available to those who pre-register by October 1st. During this break, participants can view exhibits and/or take a short tour of environmental projects in Newark.

The Congress provides a unique opportunity for anyone concerned with the New Jersey environment to learn what groups around the state are doing and to meet with other concerned citizens. Participants will consider solutions to many of New Jersey's environmental problems to maintain and expand the gains won by the activism, legislation and regulations of the sixties and seventies.

The Congress is being co-sponsored by the American Littoral Society, Delaware and Raritan Canal Coalition, League for Conservation Legislation, Middlesex-Somerset-Mercer Regional Study Council Inc., New Jersey Audubon Society. New Jersey Conservation Foundation, New Jersey League of Women Voters, New Jersey Public Interest Research Group, Sierra Club, Soil Conservation Society, South Branch Watershed Association, Stony Brook Millstone Watershed Association, Trust for Public Land, Upper Raritan Watershed Association, and the Youth Environment Society.

Cooperating agencies include the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, New Jersey Department of Transportation, New Jersey Department of Energy and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

<u>DEP Events of Public Interest include:</u> public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

Public Hearings (Quasi - Legislative) - are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide, or of broad general interest.

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal.

Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

October 1--NEW DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English announced the appointment of Jack Stanton, a veteran of 10 years with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), as Deputy Director of DEP's Division of Environmental Quality, assisting Director George J. Tyler.

October 1--DEP CERTIFIES HACKENSACK MEADOWLANDS WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN--Commissioner English announced DEP certification of the solid waste management plan of the Hackensack Meadowlands District. In approving the plan, DEP directed the District to develop a specific timetable for implementation of resource recovery facilities, and to develop agreements with Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Passaic, and Union counties for redistribution of solid waste in order to provide adequate disposal sites.

October 1--WASTEWATER TREATMENT GRANT APPLICATIONS CERTIFIED--Governor Brendan Byrne announced DEP certification of wastewater treatment grant applications totaling more than \$8 million. They are: Hamilton Township, Mercer County, a \$6.7 million grant for Miry Run interceptor and the Yardville-Groveville pump station and force main; Ocean County Utilities Authority, \$600,000 to prepare a wastewater facilities plan for disposal of sludge and septic wastes; Northwest Bergen County Sewerage Authority, \$591,800 for a wastewater facilities plan for 10 municipalities in Bergen, and Pequannock Township, Morris County, \$164,800 to prepare a wastewater facilities plan to study methods of providing sewer service to 77 percent of the township which is unsewered. The grants will be paid 75 percent by the federal government.

October 2--NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY PLAN HEARING OCTOBER 23--DEP will hold a public hearing October 23 at 7 p.m. in the Wayne Public Library, 475 Valley Road, Wayne, on the draft Water Quality Management Plan for the northeast area covering portions of Somerset, Morris, Essex, Hudson, Passaic, Bergen and Union counties.

October 2--FALL FOLIAGE TOUR BROCHURE--DEP has issued a brochure, available from the State Division of Travel and Tourism, Box 400, Trenton, N.J. 08625; N.J. Division of Parks & Forestry, Box 1420, Trenton 08625; and State Park & Dorest Offices, which outlines six areas in the State in which fall foliage displays may be seen.

October 3--PRELIMINARY FINDINGS ON NAVAL STATION EXPANSION--DEP has pinpointed number of potential conflicts with New Jersey's Coastal Management Program in proposed U.S. Navy plans for modernization and expansion of the Earle Naval Weapons Station, Middletown Township, Monmouth County. These include dredging and disposal of contaminated materials, possible intrusion of salt water into aquifers, and Public access to the bayfront. DEP asked the Navy to address these issues and other design details in its final environmental impact statement.

October 4--DEP CERTIFIES HUDSON COUNTY WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN--DEP certified the Hudson County Solid Waste Management Plan, calling for identification and analysis of solid waste collection and disposal patterns as well as development of a specific timetable for implementation of resource recovery facilities.

October 4--NUCLEAR EMERGENCY DRILL--High marks were received from federal observors for a nuclear emergency drill held by DEP and the New Jersey State Police at Public Service Electric & Gas Co.'s Salem Nucelar Generating Station. A formal report from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is due within 30 days.

October 4--NEW JERSEY GETS \$2.3 MILLION IN HERITAGE GRANTS--Six New Jersey municipalities have been awarded Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service grants totaling over \$2.3 million, according to Governor Byrne. They are: Essex County, \$1.8 million for four parks; Irvington, \$63,750 to rehabilitate Orange Avenue Park; Perty Amboy, \$85,000 to rehabilitate Chamberland Park; Hoboken, \$325,000 to rehabilitate Jefferson Recreational Center; Plainfield, \$45,659 for Hannah Atkins Park, and Camden, \$21,000 to a mobile theater.
