- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallongage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION

DEP has developed a Master Permit Information Application which, upon completion, will indicate all the DEP permits required for the project. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Office of Business Advocacy (See inside cover for details).

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

December 17--DEP CONCURS WITH FEDERAL RADIOACTIVITY CLEANUP PLAN--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of DEP announced concurrence with the U.S. Department of Energy's proposed plan to clean up low level radioactivity on a site in the Borough of Middlesex. Contamination results from operations of a uranium ore sampling plant there in the late 1940's and early 1950's. The plant is currently not in use. The three-phase cleanup is to begin in the spring of 1980.

December 21--GOVERNOR ANNOUNCES REQUEST HATCHERY PLANS--Governor Brendan Byrne said the State Commission on Capital Planning and Budgeting unanimously approved building a new trout hatchery and conservation education center near Pequest in Warren County. Bids will be taken in time to start construction early in 1980. Funding will come from Green Acres development money and a grant from the Federal Heritage, Conservation and Recreation Service. DEP's Division of Fish, Game and Wildlife will maintain the facility with funds derived from sales of hunting and fishing licenses.

December 14--FIRST TITLE TRANSFER OF PINELANDS ACQUISITION PROGRAM--Governor Brendan Byrne announced acquisition of 975 acres of land in the West Plains off Route 72 in Burlington and Ocean Counties. Total cost of the purchase from the B.E.H. Corporation, which includes the renowned "pygmy forest" is \$428,840, with reimbursement of \$224,420 from the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund.

December 18--FOUR SEWERAGE GRANTS--Governor Byrne announced sewerage construction grants totalling over \$700,000. They are: Town of Morristown, \$281,528; Warren County Municipal Utilities Authority, \$220,184 for service to Oxford Township area; Town of Belvidere, Warren County, \$192,473 for wastewater collection system, and Warren County MUA, \$6,200 to plan regional treatment plant in Belvidere area.

December 17--DEP, PVSC DISCUSS SLUDGE INCINERATOR--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of DEP and other DEP staff members met with the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission to discuss the latter agency's proposal to build a sludge incineration facility to accomodate almost 400 tons daily. George Tyler, Director of DEP's Division of Environmental Quality, noted that the facility in its present suggested form cannot be approved under federal and state air laws. A conforming facility could be achieved at great cost, he said, but it would require resolving major policy questions regarding ambient air standards for emissions, in a major urban area, and whether the additional pollution would place the area beyond acceptable state and federal air quality levels.

December 18--MORE FIREWOOD AVAILABLE--Great demand for firewood this year has led DEP to make additional wood available at Wharton and Lebanon State Forests, both in Burlington County. New Jersey residents can cut or collect firewood for personal use, with a family limit of two cords per calendar year. The fee is \$5 per cord and the program will extend to March, 1980, or until available approved wood is depleted.
