As Staff to Commissioner John J. Horn of the Department of Labor and Industry, the Office of Business Advocacy provides personalized assistance in resolving problems encountered when doing business in New Jersey. OBA's technical personnel function as industry ombudsmen in all areas of governmental activity.

The Office of Business Advocacy's objective is to cut red tape and get solutions to permit problems. OBA will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of the state permits required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit applications.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Schedule "OVER THE COUNTER" processing for permits meeting appropriate criteria.

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## OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

### I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

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December 22--NEW DEP HAZARD MANAGEMENT DIVISION--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) announced formation of the Division of Hazard Management within DEP to hold ultimate responsibility for responses to environmental emergencies and for cleanups of hazardous waste dumpsites as mandated by the State Spill Compensation and Control Act. She said also that the new division will be the focal point for obtaining federal "Superfund" resources to aid in abandoned chemical site cleanups in the State.

December 29--NEW MEMBER FOR MARINE FISHERIES COUNCIL--John T. Wells of South Orange has been appointed to the Marine Fisheries Council, which oversees development of commercial and recreational fisheries in the State, according to Russell Cookingham, Director of DEP's Division of Fish, Game and Wildlife.

December 29--ICE ACTIVITIES BANNED AT LAKE WAWAYANDA--Commissioner English announced a ban on ice-related activities such as fishing, skating and snowmobiling at Lake Wawayanda in Sussex County, due to possible hazards caused by lowering of the water level in connection with drought conditions.

January 6--SUSSEX WASTE PLAN CERTIFIED--Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English of the State Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) announced certification of the Solid Waste Management Plan for Sussex County, with modifications due on March 1 which include consideration of interdistrict agreements with Passaic, Morris and Warren Counties for disposal capacity, identification and analysis of solid waste collection and disposal patterns and development of a timetable to guarantee activation of its proposed resource recovery program.

January 6--SHOW CAUSE ORDERS FOR AUTHORITY, OPERATOR--The West Milford Municipal Utilities Authority in Passaic County and its licensed operator, Robert Jacques were ordered by DEP's Division of Water Resources to show cause why they should not be subjected to civil and criminal penalties for failing to obtain treatment works approvals and failure to keep adequate records.

January 6--POLLUTION PENALTY FOR MANALAPAN INDUSTRY--The Division of Water Resources assessed a penalty of \$1,375 against Lectro Products, Inc., of Manalapan Township for releasing untreated wastewaters into state groundwaters. The industry was ordered to either treat wastewater or transport it to a site acceptable for such wastes.

January 7--GRANTS WOULD AID BERGEN SLUDGE DUMPING PHASEOUT--Commissioner English announced approval of two grant applications totalling \$10,823,419 which would pay for purchase and installation of sludge dewatering equipment and for design of a sludge dewatering building for the Bergen County Utilities Authority. The program is aimed at ending ocean dumping of Bergen's sludge.

January 14--WHARTON FOREST LAST PLACE FOR FIREWOOD--DEP's Division of Parks and Forestry had only one site, Wharton State Forest, remaining for collection of firewood for personal use by state residents. Ten other locations had run out of wood earmarked for such purposes.

\* \* \*

January 14--CONTRACT TOWARD STATEWIDE FLOOD PLAN--Commissioner English announced awarding of a \$299,101 contract to Anderson-Nichols & Co., Boston, for engineering consultant services, to be the first step in preparation of a statewide flood control master plan.

\* \* \*

January 14--COURT UPHOLDS DEP SULFUR-IN-FUEL RULES--Commissioner English announced that State Appeals Court had rejected a challenge by Anchor Hocking Corporation to DEP's county-based regulations on sulfur in fuel. The company claimed it was at a competitive disadvantage in Salem County, compared with others in Cumberland County, where the rule is less stringent.

January 14--TO DESCRIBE DAM EMERGENCY PLANNING--The Division of Water Resources called a public meeting at 7:30 p.m. January 22 in North Hunterdon Regional High School, Clinton, to gain public inputs for an emergency response plan in the area of Spruce Run and Round Valley Reservoirs.

January 16--DEP AIDS SUSSEX IN SOLID WASTE PLANNING--DEP extended scientific and staff assistance to the Sussex County Freeholders to help the county develop options for solid waste disposal, required under its new Solid Waste Management Plan.

NOTICE: STATE CERTIFICATION OF DRAFT NPDES PERMITS

Notice is hereby given that the applicants, as listed on the following table, have applied to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the provisions of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. §1251 et seq. (the Act), for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to discharge pollutants from facilities, located as shown on the table, into navigable waters of the United States.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has certified the draft permit in accordance with the provisions of Section 401 of the Act. A description of each proposed discharge and the receiving body of water is given.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency has tentatively decided to issue a NPDES permit to the applicants. The State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has issued certifications of the draft NPDES permit subject to certain effluent limitations, standards, prohibitions, and other conditions, necessary to carry out the provisions of the Act and the "New Jersey Water Pollution Control Act," N.J.S.A. 58:10A-1 et seq. The certification formulated by DEP is based upon the administrative record.

Each administrative record is on file at the offices of the NJDEP Division of Water Resources, located on 1474 Prospect Street in the Township of Ewing, Mercer County, N.J., and may be inspected and for a fee copied between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. A copy of each state certification, and other available information may be obtained by writing to the address which appears at the top of this notice.

Interested persons may submit written comments on the state certification and administrative record to the Assistant Director, Water Quality Management at the above address cited. A copy of the comments should be sent to the Chief, Permits Administration Branch, Region II, U.S.E.P.A., 26 Federal Plaza, New York, New York 10007. All comments shall be submitted within 30 days of the date, of this public notice.

In lieu of, or in addition to, the submission of comments as above provided, any interested person may request that the Commissioner of NJDEP hold a hearing regarding the certification of the proposed discharge. Such request shall indicate the proposed issues to be considered at the hearing.

Any request for a public hearing regarding NJDEP's certification of the proposed discharge should be in writing and submitted to the Assistant Director, Water Quality Management, at the above address with a copy of the request to the Chief, Permits Administration Branch, EPA, Region II. Such request shall be submitted within 30 days of the date of this public notice.

If NJDEP orders that a public hearing be held regarding its certification, and the Enforcement Division Director of EPA, Region II, has also decided to hold a public hearing, the hearings will be held jointly by NJDEP and EPA. If the Enforcement Division Director of EPA, Region II, has decided not to hold a public hearing, NJDEP may itself hold a public hearing regarding its certification.

If NJDEP does not hold a public hearing or reopen the comment period, NJDEP will consider the issuance of the certification to be final within 30 days of the date of this public notice. All comments timely submitted by interested persons in response to this notice, and statements and other evidence properly submitted at any public hearing held by NJDEP will be considered with respect to this certification for a permit.

NJDEP's decision on the issue of whether to hold any hearing, the administration of any hearing and the rights and obligations of participants are governed by NPDES regulations (40 CFR 124) and the "Administrative Procedures Act" N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq.
