Annual Bicycle Ride to Washington, D.C. Honors Fallen Law Enforcement

Trenton, NJ - Lt. Governor Kim Guadagno joined local police officers as began the 18th Annual Police Unity Tour, an annual bicycle ride to Washington, D.C., to raise money for fallen police officers.

"As Lt. Governor and as a former Sheriff of Monmouth County, I am proud to join this year's Police Unity Tour as we remember and honor the lives of fallen officers," Lt. Governor Guadagno said. "The fallen officers we honor today stepped forward to protect their community. And today, that community comes together to honor that sacrifice."

During the annual Police Unity Tour, police officers from around the country ride their bicycles to Washington, D.C., in honor of the men and women in law enforcement who gave the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty. The ride concludes on May 12 at the National Law Enforcement Memorial, where names of officers lost in the line of duty are engraved in stone.

In addition to raising awareness of the law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty, the Police Unity Tour raises funds for the National Law Enforcement Memorial Fund. The Fund is dedicated to honoring all of America's law enforcement heroes - those who have died in the line of duty and those who continue to serve and protect.
