

Governor Christie: Let me be clear about this, as I have said every time since after Sandy happened. None of this was done perfectly. Not by the government at the federal level, not by the government at the state level, not by the governments at the county and local level, not by the non-profits. All of us were in absolutely uncharted territory, at least from the state government on down. The federal government has dealt with this before, but nothing of this scale at the state level or below has ever been dealt with before in this state. So, mistakes were made, and those mistakes were corrected. Frustrations were experienced, and many of those frustrations have been handled. None of it ever claimed to be perfect nor will it ever finish perfectly. But I come to a place like Booth today to see a family that has their business back and wouldn't have their business back if it wasn't for the fact that we all worked together to get it done. The state didn't save Booth, Booth saved Booth. And the state just helped to be a partner and that's all we ever wanted to be, a temporary partner to be able to help through a difficult time.
