Trenton, NJ – Today, Governor Chris Christie signed the following Executive Order:

Executive Order No. 141– Ordering all State buildings to fly flags at half-staff on Friday, October 4, 2013 to honor the service and sacrifice of United States Army Staff Sergeant Timothy R. McGill, a resident of Ramsey and 2001 graduate of Ramsey High School. Staff Sergeant McGill tragically lost his life while supporting Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan.
