Delayed Opening Will Allow For Clearing Of Roadways And Less Hazardous Travel Conditions During Morning Commute

Trenton, NJ - In order to allow ample time for roadways, parking lots and sidewalks to be cleared and made safe for travel, the State of New Jersey authorized a delayed opening of 10:30 am for all non-essential state employees on Monday, February 2, 2015. Essential employees should report to work on their regular schedule.

"Tonight's storm is expected to last through tomorrow morning, bringing snow and ice, creating potentially hazardous travel conditions for the morning commute," said Acting Governor Guadagno. "I strongly encourage all New Jerseyans to exercise caution on the roads tonight and tomorrow morning and, if possible, to stay off the roads so our transporation crews can do their job. I thank them and our first responders for their efforts to keep our residents safe."

Beginning tonight, a winter storm is expected to bring snow, mixed precipitation and freezing temperatures, producing hazardous travel conditions and affecting transportation across the state.
