THE NUMBERS DON'T LIE, THE LEGISLATURE MUST ACT ON SICK LEAVE REFORM

- \$3.25 Billion** Minimum long-term cost to New Jersey taxpayers of the Democrats' current proposal of a \$7,500 sick pay cap.
- \$825 Million** Current value of accumulated sick and vacation payout liability for municipalities statewide.
- \$74 Million** Estimated total accumulated Sick and Vacation Time owed to public workers in Jersey City alone.
- \$43 Million** Cost to New Jersey Taxpayers for Public Employee Sick Leave / Vacation Payouts in 2010 alone.
- \$1.2 Million** Combined payout to 7 Elmwood Park police officers who retired last week.
- \$54,000** Average payout to 700 state workers who received about \$40 million in 2010 for unused sick and vacation time according to a Times Of Trenton study.

- \$1,330** Cost per property taxpayer in New Brunswick for accumulated payouts for public workers.
- 392** Days of legislative inaction since Governor Christie issued Conditional Veto.
