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INTRODUCTION

This report, submitted to the Governor, the Legislature, and the Advisory Council on Domestic Violence pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C: 25-33, covers the period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The New Jersey Administrative Office of the Courts prepared this statistical report on the operation of the Prevention of Domestic Violence Act, N.J.S.A. 2C: 25-17 to 2C: 25-35. It reflects data gathered from case management systems that are monitored by the Family Practice Division, the Criminal Practice Division and the Municipal Court Services Division of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC). The collection of accurate data regarding trends in domestic violence proceedings serves as an essential resource for governmental agencies and service providers with regard to funding, report writing, grants, legislation, and policy recommendations.

Contained in this report is data regarding domestic violence filings, dispositions of restraining orders, and forms of relief sought and granted. This report also includes data on non-indictable contempt charges, which are processed in Family Court pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:29.9b. Figures from the Criminal and Municipal Practice Divisions, for cases containing aspects of Domestic Violence, have been included in this report.

The total number of Domestic Violence Complaints filed in the Family Court in 2015 was 32,691 which is an increase of 950 cases from the prior calendar year (31,741).

The New Jersey Judiciary continues to implement policies and procedures to enhance the protective process for victims of domestic violence and their families. The 'STOP Violence Against Women Act' (STOP VAWA) supports judicial efforts to improve the court process for victims of domestic violence. Through STOP VAWA funding, training administered by the Family Practice Division of the AOC, is provided to Judges, Family Court staff, Probation Officers who have a domestic violence caseload, court volunteers and others. Prior to their employment, Family Division Judiciary staff receive training on the dynamics of Domestic Violence and the Prevention of Domestic Violence Act. The New Jersey Judiciary endeavors to continuously promote uniform procedures, best practices and to provide a clear and concise understanding of the dynamics of domestic violence and the Prevention of Domestic Violence Act to all Judiciary staff and court volunteers. An annual statewide Domestic Violence Conference, requiring mandatory participation, is held each spring for all Family Division judges, managers and domestic violence staff. This year's event included sessions covering the adverse Childhood Impact Study, Resources Available for DV Defendants, and The Intersection of Healthcare and Judicial Services for Victims of Domestic Violence.

New Jersey's Domestic Violence Central Registry (DVCR), is a vital informational tool available to law enforcement agencies and the Judiciary. The DVCR was made possible through federal STOP VAWA funding and through inter-agency cooperation among the New Jersey Judiciary, the Attorney General's Office, local law enforcement agencies and the New Jersey State Police.

The DVCR is used to facilitate the enforcement of Temporary Restraining Orders (TROs) and Final Restraining Orders (FROs), thereby enhancing protection for victims, even when they relocate between municipalities and counties within the state. It contains up-to-date information on all restraining orders entered into the

Family Automated Case Tracking System, including registered out-of-state protection orders and information regarding violations of those orders. The DVCR also provides critical information to law enforcement as part of the screening process for individuals who apply for firearms licensing.

The New Jersey Judiciary is part of the National Criminal History Information Processing (NCHIP) database. The national crime database provides information regarding the existence and terms of a protection order issued in other states, and supports the identification of persons prohibited by federal or state law from purchasing a firearm.

The Domestic Violence Hearing Officer (DVHO) Program is a part of the Judiciary's effort to deliver an efficient court process to potential victims. The availability of the DVHO reduces the wait time for victims due to other calendar matters before a judge. The DVHO standards were recently expanded to allow for the DVHO to hear applications to amend TROs. Training continues to be an important part of the continued improvement of the DVHO program. The DVHOs and the Backup DVHOS received futher training in 2015, covering topics in the areas of Recent Developments in Family Law and LGBTQ Cultural Competencies.

The New Jersey Judiciary will continue to strive to improve the overall quality of services it provides to all. The New Jersey Judiciary will maintain effective communication and interaction between internal and external organizations to ensure standardized practices throughout the state. System improvement in combination with the continued training of judges and staff remain critical components of our efforts in addressing domestic violence.

SECTION FOUR POST-DISPOSITIONAL RELIEFS

Enforcement of Domestic Violence Temporary Restraining Orders (TROs) or Final Restraining Orders (FROs) can be pursued either through the criminal contempt process, N.J.S.A.2C:29-9b or N.J.S.A.2C:25-30, or the civil enforcement of litigant's rights under Rule 1:10-3. Under the criminal statute, violations of any restraints and certain reliefs and conditions of a restraining order require mandatory arrest and criminal prosecution. Violations of other reliefs and conditions are enforceable by the court pursuant to applicable court rules. The Family Division has jurisdiction over disorderly person's domestic violence contempt actions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C: 29-2b. This includes contempt charges that were initially indictable but have been downgraded by the Prosecutor's Office in the county of venue. The following section reports the data on those cases. It does not cover indictable contempts of the fourth degree and above, which are handled in the Criminal Division.

Criminal Practice Cases - Filings & Dispositions

A criminal case is identified as involving domestic violence when there is a charge of contempt for violating a domestic violence restraining order (N.J.S.A. 2C:29-9B) entered on the case or the case has been flagged by the Prosecutor as a case involving domestic violence. Filings include initial complaints, direct indictments and direct accusations. Indictments resulting from complaints are counted as a filing when they first enter the system as initial complaints.

A disposition is the final resolution of a case. Pre-Trial Intervention (PTI) admissions are also included in these statistics. The category 'Transfer to Family' are those contempt cases that were initially identified as indictable, but have been downgraded to disorderly person's domestic violence contempt cases by the Prosecutor's Office in the county of venue. The Family Division has jurisdiction over disorderly derson's (DP) contempt actions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2b. The category 'Transfer to Other' are those cases transferred to another jurisdiction, transferred to the Attorney General or sent to Casino Prosecution.

The number of filings and dispositions are based on the FILING date and DISPOSITION date, respectively, and are independent of one another for the time period listed.

Municipal Court Complaints - Filings & Dispositions

The following tables provide information regarding the number of domestic violence complaints processed by the municipal courts. A complaint, which may include more than one charge, is designated a domestic violence complaint if at least one charge constitutes a domestic violence offense under N.J.S.A. 2C:25-19a.

For the present analysis, a 'filed' domestic violence complaint is one that falls within the initial jurisdiction of the municipal court. This includes most domestic violence related disorderly persons and petty disorderly persons offenses. Domestic violence complaints that include indictable and other charges that statutorily fall within the jurisdiction of the Superior Court, even if filed in municipal court, are not counted. Those filings are properly reflected in the criminal section of this report.

The disposition information includes all domestic violence complaints adjudicated by a municipal court. This includes all cases falling within the initial jurisdiction of a municipal court as well as cases downgraded and remanded back to municipal court by the County Prosecutor.

The number of filings and dispositions are based on the FILING date and DISPOSITION date, respectively, and are independent of one another for the time period listed.
